1.0 PURPOSE

This Director's Rule repeals SDOT Director's Rule 2-2009.

2.0 BACKGROUND

Director's Rule 2-2009 established application and approval criteria for telecommunication facilities in the public place. The Seattle City Council passed Ordinance 124598 that added new sections to the Seattle Municipal Code to address requirements for installing communication cabinets in the public place. Ordinance 124598 supersedes Director's Rule 2-2009.

3.0 REPEAL

SDOT Director's Rule 2-2009 "Telecommunication Facilities in the Public Right-of-Way, Excluding Utility Poles and Attachments Specifications and Procedures" is repealed.
