1.0 PURPOSE

A rule related to Transportation Management Programs was adopted jointly by the Seattle Engineering Department (SED) and the Department of Design, Construction, and Lane Use (DCLU) on October 3, 1994 (SED DR 94-3 / DCLU DR 2-94). This joint rule was superseded by DCLU or its successor, the Department of Planning & Development (DPD), on April 2, 2003 (DCLU DR 12-2002), January 1, 2009 (DPD DR 19-2008), and on February 14, 2011 (DPD DR 9-2010).

2.0 REPEAL

SED Director's Rule 94-3 "Transportation Management Programs" is hereby repealed.
