1.0 PURPOSE

Administrative Rule 84-1 is related to a curb repair assistance program for the repair of integral constructed curbs and sidewalks and provides the responsibilities of the property owner and of the Seattle Engineering Department, now the Seattle Department of Transportation (Ord. 118409), in making such repairs under this program. The program described has not been in practice for many years and is not currently the Seattle Department of Transportation's preferred strategy for maintaining constructed curbs.

2.0 REPEAL

Seattle Engineering Department Administrative Rule 84-1 "Curb Repair Assistance" is hereby repealed.

The responsibility of the City to maintain the roadway, including the curb, and the responsibility of abutting property owners to maintain sidewalks, in accordance with state and municipal law, are unaffected by the repeal of this rule. Guidance for the public is available in SDOT Client Assistance Memo 2208 “Sidewalk Maintenance and Repair.”
