




## Ballard Neighborhood Greenway - 17th Avenue NW and NW 65th Street

Traffic restrictions starting as early as October 15

This week, crews working for the Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) will begin building pedestrian safety improvements (crossing beacons, curb extensions, curb ramps and crosswalks) at the intersection of NW 65th St and 17th Ave NW as part of the Ballard Neighborhood Greenway Project. In order to complete this work, access to 17th Ave NW from NW 65th St will be temporarily restricted around the clock, starting as early as Thursday, October 15, for approximately 6 weeks.

### UPCOMING CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE AND TRAFFIC ADVISORY



#### Phase 1: Beginning as early as October 15

SDOT's contractor will begin work on the south side of the intersection. For approximately 3 weeks:

- Traffic lanes on NW 65th St will be shifted north and reduced to maintain two-way traffic and accommodate the work zone on the south side of the intersection.
- 17th Ave NW will be closed to southbound through traffic from NW 65th St. Those needing local access to 17th Ave NW are encouraged to use NW 64th St via 15th Ave NW or 20th Ave NW. Through traffic is encouraged to use the arterial 15th Ave NW.
- Temporary pedestrian paths and Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) ramps will be clearly marked and installed just south of the work zone

#### Phase 2: Beginning as early as November 2

When the south side of the intersection is complete, SDOT's contractor will begin work on the north side of the intersection. For approximately 3 weeks:

- Traffic lanes on NW 65th St will be shifted south and reduced to maintain two-way traffic and accommodate the work zone on the north side of the intersection.
- 17th Ave NW will be closed to northbound through traffic from NW 65th St. Those needing local access to 17th Ave NW are encouraged to use NW 67th St via 16th Ave NW. Through traffic is encouraged to use the arterial 15th Ave NW.
- Temporary pedestrian paths and Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) ramps will be clearly marked and installed just north of the work zone.

Crews will return later this fall to install crossing beacons and crosswalks at this intersection.

### WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- Lane restrictions on NW 65th St with maintained two-way traffic
- Temporary access restrictions on 17th Avenue NW
- Normal weekday work hours from 7 AM to 5 PM
- Noise, dust, and vibration typical of construction
- Pedestrian and bicyclist detours, including temporary ADA-compliant ramps

**This work is weather dependent and may be rescheduled if needed.**
