



Ballard Neighborhood Greenway – NW 90th St

Walkway connecting NW 90th St to 17th Ave NW to be closed for 2-3 days beginning as early as October 6

The Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) will close the walkway that connects NW 90th St to 17th Ave NW for 2-3 days to replace the sidewalk adjacent to NW 90th St and make it Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant. This work is part of the Ballard Neighborhood Greenway Project and will begin as early as October 6.

We will post signs on the north and south end of the walkway to signal this temporary closure. See map at right for suggested alternate routes for pedestrians and bicyclists.


NW 90th St will remain open to through traffic. Crews will return later this fall to install a crosswalk at this location.

Project Information

The Ballard Neighborhood Greenway will connect Soundview Playfield at NW 90th St to Salmon Bay using 17th Ave NW until it turns onto NW Dock Pl and ends at Ballard Ave NW. This neighborhood greenway is one route in a citywide network of neighborhood greenways.

Greenways are residential streets made safer and calmer for people of all ages and abilities to walk and ride bikes. They are not car-free zones, and they have minimal if any on-street parking impacts. Greenways start with a good foundation—streets with already low car volumes and speeds—and make small improvements that add up to a big difference.

Construction of the Ballard Neighborhood Greenway began in early September and is expected to be done in early 2016.



WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- Temporary closure of walkway that connects NW 90th St to 17th Ave NW
- Pedestrian and bicyclist detours
- Normal work hours of 7 AM to 5 PM
- Local access maintained
- Noise, dust, and vibration typical of construction

This work is weather dependent and may be rescheduled if needed.
