BALLARD NEIGHBORHOOD GREENWAY PROJECT

Intersection redesign at 17th Ave NW and NW Dock Pl

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

In early September, SDOT's contractor painted lines and installed flexible bollards on the east side of the intersection at 17th Ave NW and NW Dock Pl to calm traffic and create a new public space. Based on traffic observations and public feedback, it appears two different designs could achieve our goals and we would like your input on each.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT THE INTERSECTION DESIGNS

- The greenway route remains the same, turning onto NW Dock Pl from 17th Ave NW
- Both designs can help us achieve our greenway goals of reduced vehicle volumes and speeds on 17th Ave NW
- Both designs create an open space opportunity

PROJECT SCHEDULE AND PROGRESS

Construction of the Ballard Neighborhood Greenway began in early-September and is expected to be done in early 2016. In general, construction of the greenway will move from north to south, with the exception of the work that is being done at 17th Ave NW and NW Dock Pl. The contractor has started with paving work, such as curb ramps and curb extensions, and will return later this fall to install crosswalks, pavement markings, and signage.
