

# BALLARD BRIDGE WALKING AND BIKING CONNECTIONS PROJECT

In 2015, we asked freight, walking and biking representatives how we could make it more comfortable to get to the Ballard Bridge and continue supporting industry in this area. This project looks at 16 recommendations resulting from the workshop.

1 Add signal at NW Leary Way & NW Dock Pl	Completed
2 Connect 17th Ave NW neighborhood greenway to Burke-Gilman Trail	Planning
3 Repurpose 15th Ave NW (west side local access way) between NW Ballard Way and NW 46th St	Evaluating Feasibility
4 Reconfigure 15th Ave NW (east side local access way) with a contra-flow bike lane	Planning
5 15th Ave NW (east side local access way) & NE Ballard Way Intersection Improvements	Planning
6 Connection between NW 46th St and NW 45th St immediately adjacent/under the Ballard Bridge	In Progress
7 Add a protected bike lane on north end ramps	Evaluating Feasibility
8 Fix drainage on bridge sidewalk and drive lanes	Evaluating Feasibility
9 Improve sidewalk pavement condition	In Progress
10 Install a railing on the concrete barrier along the full length of the bridge sidewalk	Early Planning
11 Vegetation management	In Progress
12 Add reflective tape to vertical elements	Evaluating Feasibility
13 Revise SB approach and merge location in concrete barrier onto 15th Ave NW	Evaluating Feasibility
14 Create at-grade pedestrian crossing of W Emerson St on west side 15th Ave NW	Evaluating Feasibility
15 Install a crosswalk and rapid flashing beacon at the southbound W Nickerson St merge onto 15th Ave NW	Evaluating Feasibility
16 Lighting and vegetation management for pedestrian undercrossings under the south end of the Ballard Bridge	Planning
