## Lane Reductions on S Jackson St at 25th Ave S Begin November 17

The Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) will begin construction of new curb ramps and new sidewalk at the intersection of 25th Ave S and S Jackson St on Tuesday, November 17, 2015. This work is part of Phase 2 installation of the Central Area Neighborhood Greenway Project.

Weather permitting, this work is expected to be complete during the week of November 30.

A pedestrian flashing beacon will be installed at this location in December 2015 and activated in early 2016.

### Lane and Street Closures

During this work, S Jackson St will be reduced to one lane in each direction from 7 AM to 4 PM, Monday through Friday. Flaggers will be on site to assist pedestrians.

Crews will begin by closing the north side of the intersection. Drivers and pedestrians will not be able to turn north on 25th Ave S from S Jackson St. When crews move to the south side of the intersection the week of November 23, 25th Ave S will be closed to vehicles and pedestrians turning south from S Jackson St.

### Project Information

Earlier this year, SDOT installed Phase 1 of the Central Area Neighborhood Greenway on residential streets parallel to 23rd Ave between S Jackson St and E John St. Phase 2 of the greenway runs between S Hill St and S Jackson St, primarily on 24th Ave S, 25th Ave S, and 26th Ave S.


Phase 2 will be complete by spring 2016.

### WHAT TO EXPECT DURING GREENWAY INSTALLATION

- Temporary lane reductions and street closures
- Normal work hours will be from 7 AM to 4 PM
- Temporary on-street parking restrictions
- Pedestrian and bicycle detours
- Light construction noise
- Access to residences will be maintained except when temporary restrictions are necessary
- Phase 2 installation will be complete by spring 2016
