


S LANDER STREET BRIDGE PROJECT

Project Background

S Lander St is an essential east-west corridor in Seattle's SODO neighborhood. Every day, the corridor serves freight, commuters, pedestrians, and bicyclists.

What's Next?

To improve traffic, freight, and safety, SDOT will build a bridge over the train tracks on S Lander St between 1st Ave S and 4th Ave S. We are currently updating the project design, originally developed in 2007, thanks to the recent voter approved Levy to Move Seattle and funding from the State legislature.
