Linden Avenue Complete Street Project

North 128th to North 145th streets

July 19, 2012

Grinding work set to begin next week

The Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) is redeveloping Linden Avenue North between N 128th and N 145th streets into a neighborhood-friendly roadway that is safer for all users. Construction began on June 18, in Zone 2, from N 135th to N 141st streets, and will continue in this area for the next few weeks.

Starting the week of July 23, SDOT will begin grinding and removing the existing asphalt roadway from N 135th to N 141st streets. Roadway grinding will take 2-3 days. Crews plan to repave this stretch of Linden around the 2nd week of August. In addition to grinding and paving, crews will also build new curbs and gutters and install new segments of sidewalk.

What to expect during grinding:

- Construction noise and dust
- Pedestrian detours
- Bicyclists will merge northbound and share lanes with vehicles
- Increased truck activity
- On-street parking restrictions 24 hours a day, seven days a week

What to expect after grinding:

- Partial or full width gravel roadways and raised utility castings
- Temporary traffic channelization
- Bicyclists will merge northbound and share lanes with vehicles.
- Realignment of a temporary sidewalk on the west side of Linden between N. 141st and N. 138th streets.
- On-street parking restrictions 24 hours a day, seven days a week

Project Work Hours and Schedule

Normal work hours will be 7 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday through Friday with possible weekend work 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. Saturday and Sunday.



What's Next?

- Construction activity in Zone 2 will be substantially complete by late August.
- On August 1 crews will begin preparing for construction in Zone 1 - from North 145th to North 141st streets.
- Initial work in Zone 1 includes installing storm drainage structures in preparation for the new roadway, curbs, gutters and sidewalks.
- Southbound traffic will be detoured.
- Street users should also expect long-term parking and loading restrictions, pedestrian detours and increased truck traffic.
- Construction in Work Zone 1 is expected to be substantially complete by early October.
