Oct. 9 meeting for Magnolia Bridge

SEATTLE -- The Seattle Department of Transportation will hold an open house 5:30-8:30 p.m. Wednesday, Oct. 9 to discuss the **Magnolia Bridge** replacement project. It will be an opportunity to provide input toward possible locations and other design opportunities. The meeting will be held at Blaine K-8 School, 2550 34th Ave. W.

The **bridge** was severely damaged in the Nisqually earthquake. Engineers determined it is not cost effective to retrofit the **bridge**. The first phase of the design is expected to take 10 to 12 months, and will result in a recommendation for replacing the **bridge**.

A design advisory group will meet regularly to track the design process. Two more open houses will be scheduled later in the study process.
