

# Construction Notice

## Mercer Corridor Project Mercer East Construction

September 17, 2010

### Lane Closures on Broad St. and Boren Ave. N

Beginning as early as September 22, the eastbound right-hand lane of Broad St. between Dexter Ave. N and 9th Ave. N will be closed, including the off-ramp access to the single westbound lane on Mercer St. Additionally, Boren Ave. N between Valley St. and Mercer St. will be closed in preparation for the construction of utility and other work located to the north of existing Mercer St. within the future westbound lanes.

### Where & When:

- On Broad St. between Dexter Ave. N and 9th Ave. N. as early as September 22
- On Boren Ave. N between Valley St. and Mercer St. as early as September 22

**Why:** The Broad St. off-ramp closure allows crews to prepare for a full closure of eastbound Broad St. that will occur in the next two to three weeks. Further information about eastbound Broad St. closures and traffic detours will be available soon.

Closing eastbound Broad St. will also allow construction of an interim connection from future westbound Mercer St. lanes to westbound Broad St., as well as a new eastbound Broad St. connection at 8th Ave. N. This closure will help manage traffic during construction of both 9th Ave. N and Westlake Ave. N by redirecting eastbound traffic away from the intersection of Broad and 9th.

Closing Boren Ave. N allows crews to install new underground utilities and will accommodate construction of new westbound Mercer St. lanes.

### What to Expect During Construction:

- Lane closures and traffic detours
- Sidewalk closures and pedestrian detours
- Noise, dust, vibration and increased truck traffic
- Parking restrictions
