
West Mercer Place


- Evaluate Feasibility and Need For:

Mercer Underpass

- Three Lanes in Each Direction
- Median/Left-Turn Lane
- 12-16' Sidewalks
- Bicycle Path
- Project Coordination: WSDOT (Viaduct Replacement), Mercer East, The Gates Foundation, Lake to Bay Trail, Seattle Center





5th Ave N to 5th Ave W

- Two Lanes in Each Direction on Mercer St (Fifth Ave N–Fifth Ave W)
- One Lane Each Direction on Roy St (Fifth Ave N–Queen Anne Ave N)
- Bike Lanes on Roy St
- All Changes Within the Existing Street Right-of-Way
- Project Coordination: Seattle Center, RapidRide



- Create a Direct Connection From I-5 and SR 99 to Seattle Center, Uptown, Queen Anne, and Interbay
- Improve Pedestrian and Bicycle Connection Across SR 99

- Add a New Option for Freight From I-5 to Interbay
- Connect the Uptown and South Lake Union Urban Centers
- Enhance Transit Access
