## Mercer Corridor Project Mercer East Construction

February 4, 2011

### Aloha St. to Broad St.: 9th Ave. N Sewer Installation Continues

Expect increased construction activity to complete installation of a new 30-inch diameter sewer line. To minimize surface impacts, much of the construction activity will continue to occur below ground, using a pipe reaming machine to bore through the soil and place the new pipe. A temporary sewer bypass has been constructed to allow work on the existing sewer line. Nearby neighbors, businesses and travelers can expect:

- Flaggers directing traffic on 9th Ave. N between Aloha St. and Broad St.
- Access pits and heavy machinery such as backhoes, front loaders and dump trucks
- Continued lane and sidewalk closures with appropriate traffic, bicycle and pedestrian detours
- Noise, dust, and vibration

**Work Hours:** Weekdays and weekends. Crews may work up to 24 hours per day if required.

**Duration:** Approximately two weeks

### Broad St. to Republican St.: Side Sewer Excavations

Excavation work will occur to connect side sewers to a temporary sewer bypass to support the mainline sewer replacement work. *No interruption to sewer service is expected.* Nearby neighbors, businesses, and travelers can expect:

- Continued lane and sidewalk closures with appropriate traffic, bicycle and pedestrian detours
- Noise, dust, and vibration


**Work Hours:** Weekday work, 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

**Duration:** Approximately two weeks

### What's Next?

- Continue installation of new sewer line on 9th Ave. N between Aloha St. and Broad St.
- Begin operating sewer bypass; install new sewer line on 9th Ave. N between Broad St. and Republican St.
