

Northbound Fairview Ave. N closure beginning Tuesday, February 26

What: Fairview Ave. N north of Valley St. will be closed to northbound traffic beginning, Tuesday February 26th for approximately two weeks.


Purpose: This closure will accommodate demolition and restoration of Fairview Ave. N in preparation for re-opening Fairview Ave. N to traffic in March.

Traffic Routing: Traffic headed northbound on Fairview Ave. N will be routed east on Valley St. then north on Minor Ave. N to the intersection of Fairview Ave. N at Aloha St. Southbound access on Fairview Ave. N to Valley Street will be maintained.

Detour signs will be posted and flaggers will be utilized to maintain traffic flow and assist vehicles and equipment entering and exiting the work zone. Local access will be coordinated with business and property owners.

Please note: Due to restricted turning radiuses through the detour, large freight heading northbound on Fairview Avenue N should use I-5 to reach their destinations.

Duration: Fairview Ave. N north of Valley St. will be closed beginning at 8:00 am on February 26th for approximately two weeks, 24 hours a day and 7 days a week.
