

# Upcoming Weekend Closures of Fairview Ave. N

**What:** Two weekend closures of Fairview Ave. N between Republican St. and Mercer St. with additional lane restrictions between Mercer St. and Valley St. will occur the following weekends:

- **March 30 – April 2**
- **April 13 – April 16**

**Purpose:** These closures will allow crews to install underground electrical utilities on Fairview Ave. N.

**Traffic Routing:** Traffic exiting I-5 at Mercer St. must turn right onto Fairview Ave. N and use Valley St. to 9th Ave. N and head southbound if going to South Lake Union or downtown. To access I-5 from south of Mercer St., use Republican St. to 9th Ave. N to Mercer St. Eastbound traffic on Mercer St. will not be able to turn right or left onto Fairview Ave. N and detour signs will be posted. **NOTE: The I-5 on- and off-ramps at Mercer St. will remain open at all times.**

**Duration:** Fairview Ave. N closure will begin Friday at 7:00 p.m. and will re-open Monday at approximately 5:00 a.m.



### Additional Fairview Ave. N Restrictions Postponed Until Summer/Fall 2012

SDOT is postponing the previously announced restrictions on Fairview Ave. N due to current reduced street capacity as part of Stage 2 of Mercer East. In lieu of beginning full-time restrictions on Fairview Ave. N, the contractor will close Fairview Ave. N on select weekends to perform necessary Stage 2 work needed in order to open Mercer St. to two-way traffic later this summer or early fall. Once two-way Mercer is open to traffic, access to Mercer St. from the south via Westlake, Terry, and Boren avenues will be re-opened and the contractor will begin implementing severe Fairview Ave. N traffic restrictions. Postponing this work will result in improved alternate routing options during construction along Fairview Ave. N.
