Upcoming Road Closure on Mercer St. East of Fairview Ave. N

Beginning as early as Tuesday, July 5, Mercer St. between Fairview Ave. N and Minor Ave. N will be closed to accommodate underground utility installations.

Purpose: Allow installation of underground electrical and communications lines.

Duration: Approximately two to three months.

Work Hours: Work is scheduled for daytime during the week, but road closure will remain in place at all times during this work. Nighttime and weekend work may occur if needed.


Traffic Routing: Eastbound Mercer St. traffic traveling to Eastlake Ave. E can use Fairview Ave. N. and Republican St. to navigate around the closure. Please note the intersection of Minor Ave. N and Mercer St. will experience intermittent closures to accommodate utility installations crossing Minor.

Bicycle & Pedestrian

Routing: One sidewalk or the other (north side or south side) along Mercer St. east of Fairview Ave. N will be open and for use by both pedestrians and bicyclists. Sidewalks on Republican St. will also be open during this work.

Access to businesses and residences will be maintained during construction and will be coordinated directly with property owners and managers.
