## 42nd Avenue SW - near SW Lander Street and SW College Street

**Type of Improvement:** Sidewalk

### **Applicant Description of Problem and/or Project:**

**Problem:** None given

**Suggested Project:** Improve pedestrian experience and amenities to increase the quantity and value of pedestrian traffic already this important stretch from Hiawatha Park to the Library. Some things that would help accomplish this and were discussed in planning for street improvements using early implementation funds: Increase greenery-trees, planting beds, Pedestrian lighting, remove parking signs in middle of sidewalk on west side b/w Lander and California, Different paving at crosswalk especially Admiral, Park and Library signage, benches, trash containers, A number of these things were implemented along Admiral already.

### **Potential Solution and/or Comments:**

42<sup>nd</sup> Avenue SW from SW Lander St. to SW College St.

- Construct concrete curb, gutter, 5-foot planting strip, and 6-foot concrete sidewalk for approximately 550 feet on the west side of 42<sup>nd</sup> Avenue SW between SW Lander St and Admiral Way.
- Install 2 catch basins and connecting storm drain system to catch street runoff.
- Remove existing parking signs in the middle of the sidewalk on the west side of 42<sup>nd</sup> Avenue SW.

### **Challenges/Tradeoffs:**

- Parking may be prohibited on the west side of 42<sup>nd</sup> Avenue SW between SW Lander St and SW Admiral Way.
- There is a short segment north of SW Admiral Way where there is insufficient right-of-way to maintain the desirable street width and install a planting strip. In this section, a planting strip will not be constructed.

**Preliminary Range of Cost:** \$ 370,000 to \$ 470,000
