



# Delridge Ave SW



## **Project ID # Delridge SDOT Project**

**Type of Improvement:** Pedestrian  
**Neighborhood:** Delridge

**Approximate Length:**  
**Street Classification:** major arterial

## **Description of Problem and/or Project:**

Delridge Ave SW is the major arterial and transit route through the Delridge neighborhood. Many streets intersect Delridge Ave SW at an angle making for long crossings as people walk north and south along the corridor. In addition, wheelchair curb ramps are needed along the corridor. This section of Delridge Ave SW was chosen because of its proximity to two schools and several multi-family housing developments in the area (at Croft Place).

Specific pedestrian improvements could include:

- Pedestrian crossing improvements at Chief Sealth High School (such as median island)
- Intersection improvements next to Chief Sealth High School (23<sup>rd</sup> Ave SW, SW Graham St and 24<sup>th</sup> Ave SW). Intersections could be squared up and have ADA access ramps installed.
- ADA access ramps at pedestrian signal at SW Holly Street
- Pedestrian crossing improvements at Croft Place SW for the people who live in the two housing developments to better access the bus stop across the street. In addition, the entrance to Croft Place SW from Delridge Ave SW could be better delineated. Currently, drivers tend not to slow down as they turn onto the street.

SDOT would work with the adjacent property owners to determine the best type of crossing improvements to install at these locations.
