

**SEPA DETERMINATION OF NON-SIGNIFICANCE (DNS)
SEATTLE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO ALLOW THREE PILOT PARKLETS**

Description of proposal: The Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) proposes to allow development of three pilot parklet projects. Parklets are structures that provide public spaces with seating and amenities in the boundaries of on-street parking spaces. The three pilot parklet will displace one to three parking spaces each and are located in Belltown, Capitol Hill, and the International District neighborhoods.

Location of proposal: The first parklet is located at 2327 Second Avenue, in the Belltown neighborhood. The second parklet is located 1506 East Olive Way, in the Capital Hill neighborhood. The third parklet is located at 421 Sixth Avenue South, in the International District neighborhood. The project is located in Township 25 North, Range 04 East, Section 5, 9, 31

SDOT has determined that this proposal would not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21C.030(2)(c). This decision was made after review of a completed environmental checklist and other information on file with the lead agency. This information may be examined in the Seattle Department of Planning and Development Public Resource Center at 700 Fifth Avenue, Suite 2000, Seattle. Documents are also available at the main branch of the Seattle Public Library, 100 Fourth Avenue, Seattle, WA 98104.

There is no comment period for this DNS.

This DNS is issued after using the optional DNS process in WAC 197-11-355. There is no further comment period on the DNS.

This DNS is issued under WAC 197-11-340(2) and Seattle Municipal Code (SMC) 25.05.340; the lead agency will not act on this proposal for 14 days from the issue date below. **Comments must be submitted by 5:00 p.m. on August 7, 2013**

Box 94729, Seattle, WA 98124-4729; or the Office of the Hearing Examiner located on the 40th floor of the Seattle Municipal Tower at 700 Fifth Avenue.; telephone: (206) 684-0521. **The appeal must be in writing and filed no later than 5:00 p.m. on August 14, 2013.** The appellant should be prepared to make specific factual objections.
