# What is the relationship between the Elliott Bay Seawall Project and the city's Central Waterfront Project?



## Central Waterfront Stakeholder Group and Seawall Project Subgroup (25-30 ppl)

- Provides ongoing and direct feedback to city staff and consultant team as design is developed
- Functions as forum for specific stakeholders' issues to be heard and for project team to respond
- Meets for duration of the project, with Seawall Project Subgroup convening prior to Central Waterfront Stakeholder Group

## Seattle Waterfront Steering Committee (8-10 ppl)

- Provides holistic oversight of waterfront design including seawall, public spaces, and other related projects
- Ensures robust and innovative public engagement, including coordination with stakeholder committee and other groups
- Deliberates as a group and advises city at key milestones
