18th Ave S at S Washington St & Main St Sidewalk Repair Project

Project Planned for February 2014

The Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) will replace broken and uplifted sections of sidewalk along 18th Ave S. Work is planned to begin in February.


Project Elements

- Remove and replace damaged sidewalk at these locations:
 - The west side of 18th Ave S between S Washington St and S Main St in front of Kawabe Memorial House
 - At the southwest and northwest corners of the intersection of 18th Ave S and S Main St
- SDOT does not plan to remove street trees at these locations.
- 72 hours before the work starts and parking restrictions begin, "No Parking" signs will be placed on 18th Ave S.

Actions for Residents

- Please contact SDOT** if you have any information that may be useful for this project. For example, timing of special events or deliveries, special needs of users of the sidewalk, etc.
- Adjacent property owners are required to **trim vegetation** to leave a 1 foot space between the sidewalk and the vegetation. This is necessary for workers to remove and replace the sidewalk.
- SDOT is not responsible for damage to private property in the public right-of-way** such as landscaping, artwork or sprinkler systems in the planting strip or on the sidewalk. Property owners may wish to remove such items before the project begins.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- Parking restrictions on 18th Ave S
- Pedestrian detours
- Moderate construction noise & dust
- Normal work hours will be 8am – 4 pm Mon. – Fri.
- Access will be maintained to businesses and residences.
