


SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL



MINI GRANTS

Mini Grants provide assistance to schools, PTAs, and community groups to support safety education and encouragement for walking and bicycling to school.

RECIPIENT ELIGIBILITY:

All state-approved public and private K-12 schools, PTAs, and other school-related nonprofit groups are eligible to apply. Recipients from previous years are eligible to apply again if end of year reports have been submitted.

PROJECT ELIGIBILITY:


Groups can request up to \$1,000 to be spent within up to two years. Funds must be used for programs that improve conditions for walkers and bikers, educate kids on safe walking and biking behaviors, or encourage more kids to ride their bikes or walk to school.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS *(To apply, follow these two simple steps):*

1. Complete the Mini Grant Application and submit by **October 25, 2013** by end of business day.
2. Email or mail a letter of support from your principal by the application due date.

- Notice of decisions will be sent out by December 6th, 2013.
- Funding will be distributed after January 1st, 2014.
- A summary report of how funds were used with photos is due by December 31st, 2014.
