Notify regulars ahead of time and invite them to the party.



What you need to know



- Parking will be restricted and vehicles not allowed on 22nd Avenue NW between NW Market Street and Ballard Avenue NW from **7 a.m. to 8 p.m.**
- If your business is on 22nd Avenue NW, you may use the sidewalk or street space.
- Schedule deliveries and pick-ups on the Thursday before or Saturday after the event.
- If you are serving alcohol or food observe WA State Alcohol Beverage and King County Public Health codes and obtain necessary permits.
- Leave at least four feet of sidewalk space for wheelchair access and set tables close to the curb, or in the planting strip.
- If you are having a street sale instead of a sidewalk sale, keep displays next to the sidewalk curb to ensure space for emergency access.
