


What You Need to Know

LEGEND

- Street Closed from 9 a.m. - 11 a.m.
- Event Location
Street Closed from 9 a.m. - 5 p.m.
- Street Open

NOTE: No Parking starts at 8 a.m.



- Parking will be restricted along the waterside of Alki Avenue SW from 1200 block Alki SW (west of Duwamish Head) to 63rd Avenue SW from 8 a.m. to 11 a.m.
- No parking allowed along Alki Avenue SW between 56th Avenue SW and 63rd Avenue SW from 8 a.m. until 5 p.m.
- Whatever activity you are engaged in, leave at least four feet of space free on sidewalks so wheelchair's can move through safely.
- To minimize impacts to transit, the Water Taxi Shuttle and Metro bus Route 56 will detour at 63rd and Admiral during the event.
- Access exceptions will be made for emergency vehicles and people with disabilities.
