




What you need to know



- Parking will be restricted on Rainier Avenue S between S Alaska and S Brandon streets and on Ferdinand between 37th and Rainier from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.
- Parking will be restricted and vehicles not allowed along S Edmunds and S Hudson between Rainier and 39th Avenue S between 8 a.m. and 4 p.m.
- Parking will be restricted and vehicles not allowed along 42nd Avenue S between Rainier Avenue S and S Ferdinand Street from 8 a.m. to noon.
- Metro bus route 7 will be rerouted from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m. at S Orcas and S Alaska streets to Martin Luther King Way.
- If your business is on Rainier Avenue S, you may use the sidewalk or street space.
- Schedule deliveries and pick-ups on Friday or after 3 p.m. on Saturday.
- If you are serving alcohol or food observe WA State Alcohol Beverage and King County Board of Health codes and obtain necessary permits.
- Contact the Fire Marshal's Office if you plan on using tents or propane.
- Leave at least four feet of sidewalk space for wheelchair access and set tables close to the curb, or in the planting strip.
