

West Seattle 5K Run/Walk and Alki Seattle Summer Streets Frequently Asked Questions

April 2010

What if Alki Avenue is the only way I can get to and from my home?

Residents along Alki will have access to their homes via an eastbound-only travel lane.

We ask that you participate in the spirit of the event and only drive if necessary.

The water taxi shuttle will operate on its normal Sunday schedule and may be a good travel option.

When will the no-parking zone kick in?

Vehicles cannot park within the event area from 8AM to 5PM on Sunday, May 23.

Where can I park my car? I live in a condo and don't have on-site parking.

If you have to move your car from Alki Avenue for the event, you may want to look for parking along Harbor Avenue SW, south of SW California Avenue or other public parking lots in the area.

What if I park on the planting strip?

Technically parking on the planting strip is illegal. We do not suggest this activity and encourage you to park elsewhere.

Will my car be towed?

Towing could happen if the owner of a vehicle cannot be located and the vehicle causes a safety issue or impedes the movement of the 5K Run/Walk and water taxi shuttle through the area.
