


Seattle Department of Transportation Restricted Parking Zone (RPZ) Notice of Decision

The Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) will add University of Washington Husky football Saturday game-day parking restrictions to the existing Restricted Parking Zone (RPZ) 6 restrictions.

A public hearing regarding this topic was held May 29, 2013. In addition, comments were taken through an online survey, by phone and by e-mail through June 7, 2013.

The existing RPZ restricts those without an RPZ permit to two hours of parking, Monday through Friday, from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.

Game-day restrictions will not allow parking by anyone without a Zone 6 RPZ permit on the days of UW Husky football games, starting three hours before the games and ending two hours after the games.

The SDOT decision is to agree with a majority of the residents, and add the Husky game-day restrictions to the zone. Residents with existing RPZ permits will be able to use those permits during the Saturday game-day restrictions.
