


PROPOSED PARKING CHANGES

SDOT's Community Parking Program has been comprehensively studying parking in West Seattle Junction (WSJ) this year.

Parking study data shows:

- 2-hour time limit parking is well used throughout the day
- Drivers comply with time limits over 90% of the time on California Ave SW and over 80% of the time on adjacent residential streets
- Parking is used most during mid-morning and afternoon hours
- In unrestricted parking spaces most cars park for a short time:
 - On California Ave SW over 70% of drivers park for 3 hours or less
 - On residential streets adjacent to California Ave SW over 50% of drivers park for 3 hours or less

Proposals for WSJ parking management:

- Add 2-hour time limits to blocks next to businesses and community spaces to make customer and visitor parking easier to find
- Convert current 1-hour time limits to 2-hour time limits to improve predictability for customers and visitors
