

# Seattle Department of Transportation Restricted Parking Zone (RPZ) Notice of Decision


The Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) will add multiple blocks to two existing RPZs, Zones 4 and 21 in the Capitol Hill neighborhood.

These changes are part of the Community Parking Program for Capitol Hill. A public hearing regarding this topic was held March 9, 2010.

The new Zone 4 RPZ blocks will be installed as proposed, with a 2-hour time limit from 7 am to 6 pm, Monday through Saturday, except by Zone 4 permit.

The new Zone 21 RPZ blocks have been modified from the original proposal. Unpaid blocks will have a 2-hour time limit from 7 am until 6 pm, Monday through Saturday (except by Zone 21 permit), rather than until 10 pm as had been proposed. Residents with a Zone 21 permit will be able to park on blocks with pay stations that are marked with "Zone 21" eligibility, which is unchanged from the original proposal.

Residents will receive applications in the mail with information about how to purchase RPZ permits prior to implementation of the zone.
