

Seattle Department of Transportation Restricted Parking Zone (RPZ) Notice of Decision

As an outcome of the First Hill Community Parking Program, SDOT will add new RPZ blocks to Zones 7 and 21. This decision follows a May 25, 2010 public hearing.



New **Zone 7** RPZ blocks will be installed as proposed.


New **Zone 21** RPZ blocks will also be installed as proposed. Note that the time limit is currently 7 am-10 pm, daily, and will change to 8 am-6 pm, Mon-Sat (as proposed). An additional block will be added to the original proposal (see map).



In both zones, SDOT will also install pay stations on RPZ blocks. If you have an RPZ permit, you may park on pay station blocks marked with either Zone 7 or Zone 21 eligibility. Your permit number must match the RPZ sign.

As signs may not be installed until the fall, please wait until August to apply for your permit.
