## New Hours for Paid Parking Pay to Park until 8 p.m.

**The city of Seattle is extending paid parking to 8 p.m.**

### **What neighborhoods are getting evening hours?**

The City of Seattle is extending hours in Downtown, Belltown, Pioneer Square, Chinatown/International District, Capitol Hill, Pike-Pine, Uptown, and the University District.

### **Why?**

These vibrant business districts are active destinations for people late into the evening. Currently a person can pay for two hours of parking at 4 p.m. and lock a space up until the next morning. Extending parking time limits and paid parking until 8 p.m. improves customer access and makes it easier to find a parking space.

### **How will this change take place?**

The change is occurring on a block-by-block basis, as each pay station is reprogrammed by hand. Signs on each block indicate extended paid parking to 8 p.m. New graphics on the pay stations also show the extended hours.

### **How much will it cost to park?**

The rate is posted on each pay station.

### **Do other cities charge for parking after 6 p.m.?**

Yes, Portland, Denver, Boston, Vancouver BC, New York, Charlotte, Austin, Los Angeles, and Washington, DC do.
