We request that the Seattle Department of Transportation consider removing our block (both sides of the street) from our neighborhood's Restricted Parking Zone (Zone \_\_\_\_). We understand that SDOT will apply the following criteria as it considers our request: 1) zone contiguousness and 2) our block's proximity to the light rail station.

We understand that by removing the restriction we will no longer be eligible to purchase a zone permit, which would exempt our vehicles from the RPZ restrictions in the area. Any permits purchased must be returned and a refund can be issued upon written request.

We understand that if the zone is removed from our block that anyone can park on this street for up to 72 hours, including those parking to access the light rail station. If more than two contiguous blocks request zone removal, we also understand that SDOT will schedule a public hearing before moving forward with any changes.

**INSTRUCTIONS:** Please fill out the top portion of the petition form and circulate it through the petition area. The petition area consists of residences on both sides of the street for one block where the change is to occur. Every residence must be contacted. Signatures are needed from at least 60% of the households in the petition area to enable us to initiate the change requested. Where the household is an apartment building or condominium each unit is considered a household. Only one signature per household is required. Please make a note of any known vacancies or refusal to sign within the petition area.
