






There will be an **Open House** on **July 11** about  
parking changes along Westlake Avenue North.

The **Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT)** and the Westlake Community Parking Workgroup have jointly developed a new parking management plan for Westlake Avenue North from Valley Street to the Fremont Bridge.

While two-thirds of the 1,300 parking spaces will remain free and without time-limit restrictions, the plan includes areas of two-hour paid parking as well as provisions for residential parking.

Please join SDOT and the Westlake Community Parking Workgroup July 11 for an open house, and a chance to hear presentations on the plan, and to speak with SDOT staff and Workgroup members about plan details.
