CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC LIABILITY, PROPERTY DAMAGE INSURANCE

Seattle Transportation requires a Certificate of Public Liability, Property Damage Insurance for some types of Street Use Permits.

Minimum requirements:

\$1,000,000	Bodily Injury Liability
\$ 250,000	Property Damage Liability
or \$1,000,000	Combined Single Limit Bodily Injury and Property Damage

The insurance policy must cover the period of the permit.

Wording on Certificate of Insurance (Rider) to the City of Seattle must be as follows:

The City of Seattle shall be an additional insured, under the above numbered insurance policy, as respects the street use permit issued by the City of Seattle.

The City of Seattle shall be given twenty (20) days notice of any change, cancellation, expiration or renewal of the policy.

Coverage must be provided under a Comprehensive General Liability and Automobile Liability form of insurance, such as is usual to the practice of the insurance industry, including (but not limited to) all the usual coverages referred to as:

Premises/Operations Liability (M&C)

Owners and Contractors Protective Liability

Products and Completed Operations Liability

* Blanket Contractual Liability

Broad Form Property Damage Liability

Personal Injury, including coverage A, B and C

Stop Gap or Employers Contingent Liability

* Explosion, collapse, underground damage (referred to as "X,C,U")

Automobile Liability, including coverage for owned, non-owned, leased or hired vehicles

* City of Seattle named as an additional insured as a result of negligence real or alleged.
