

# EMERGENCY WESTERN AVENUE WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT PROJECT

Construction update for November 21 to December 4


Emergency work continues on Western Avenue to replace a water main at risk of failure. From November 21 to December 4, you can expect the following impacts in the project area:

## CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

- Work will occur on Western Avenue between Spring and Columbia streets. Crews will not work on Thanksgiving Day, Thursday, November 26, through Sunday, November 29. Work will resume Monday through Saturday starting the week of November 30.
- Work will include sawcutting and excavating between Spring and Madison streets. Excavating and installing new pipe will occur between Madison and Marion streets with increased noise and dust.
- Restoration work will occur between Marion and Columbia streets.
- Some weekday night work is expected over the next two weeks, with the noisiest work completed by 10 p.m. each night.

## ACCESS AND PARKING

- Western Avenue between Spring and Columbia streets will be closed to vehicle traffic from 6 a.m. to 3 p.m.
- One southbound lane will be open from 3 p.m. to 6 a.m. with some intermittent closures to accommodate work.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained.
- Large vehicles travelling southbound on Western Avenue should detour at Lenora or University streets.
- Steel plates will be present on the roadway. Bicyclists should use extreme caution.
- On-street parking between Marion and Columbia streets is anticipated to be restored the week of December 7.
