

EMERGENCY WESTERN AVENUE WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT PROJECT

Project update March 24, 2016

PROJECT COMPLETE

Seattle Public Utilities (SPU) has installed a new water main along Western Avenue from Yesler Way to Spring Street. The new, 24-inch steel water main is able to absorb additional ground settlement and withstand seismic activity. We thank you for your patience as we completed this emergency work in your neighborhood.
