

## **Construction and Demolition Waste Recycling Required Ordinance**

An ordinance will be introduced in June 2012 that will include the following components:

### **1) Phased Landfill Disposal Bans and an Implementation Schedule for 2012 – 2015** (see page 2)

- Exceptions to this list and a process for Administrative Rulemaking for adopting a different implementation schedule if end markets are no longer available or facilities close
- Civil infractions for non-compliance on the part of generators and/or facilities may apply during the second effective year of any one particular disposal ban

### **2) Certification of Facilities that Comply with Recycling Requirements and other Criteria**

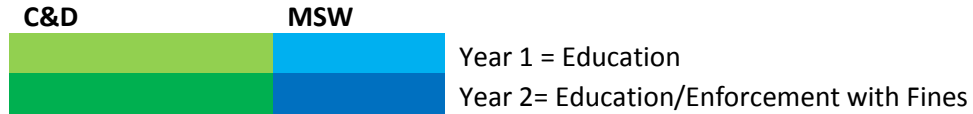
SPU will develop through Administrative Rulemaking specific criteria and standards by **March 30, 2013** for approving both receiving and recycling facilities. A list of approved facilities will be published by **June 2013**. Criteria will include:

- Compliance with existing health and environmental regulations
- Reporting to the City on a quarterly basis on facility inputs and outputs
- Achievement of minimum recycling levels by type of facility (mixed C&D and source-separated recyclers)
- Not exceeding a percentage threshold of targeted recyclables left in the residual from processing which is bound for landfill disposal or used as either alternative daily cover or industrial waste stabilizer in a landfill - **the measurement process for this will be developed in 2012**

### **3) Building Permit Applicants Compliance with Recycling Requirements**

- Submittal of an electronic Waste Diversion Summary to DPD within 60 days of the Final Permit being issued **effective January 1, 2014**
- Waste Diversion Summary documents the tonnage and destination of where materials were delivered for processing and disposal – the easiest way for the generator to be in compliance with the recycling requirements is to use approved facilities on the City's Certification list
- Applicants can also use alternative Waste Diversion Summary electronic tracking systems such as Green Halo in order to track material tonnages and destinations
- Periodic audits may be conducted of projects so generators need to keep weight receipts for a limited time period
- **As of January 1, 2015**, a civil penalty may apply in those cases where building permit applicants have not submitted a Waste Diversion Summary or did not use approved facilities on the City's certification list (or submit proof that other facilities not on the list meet the City's standards).
