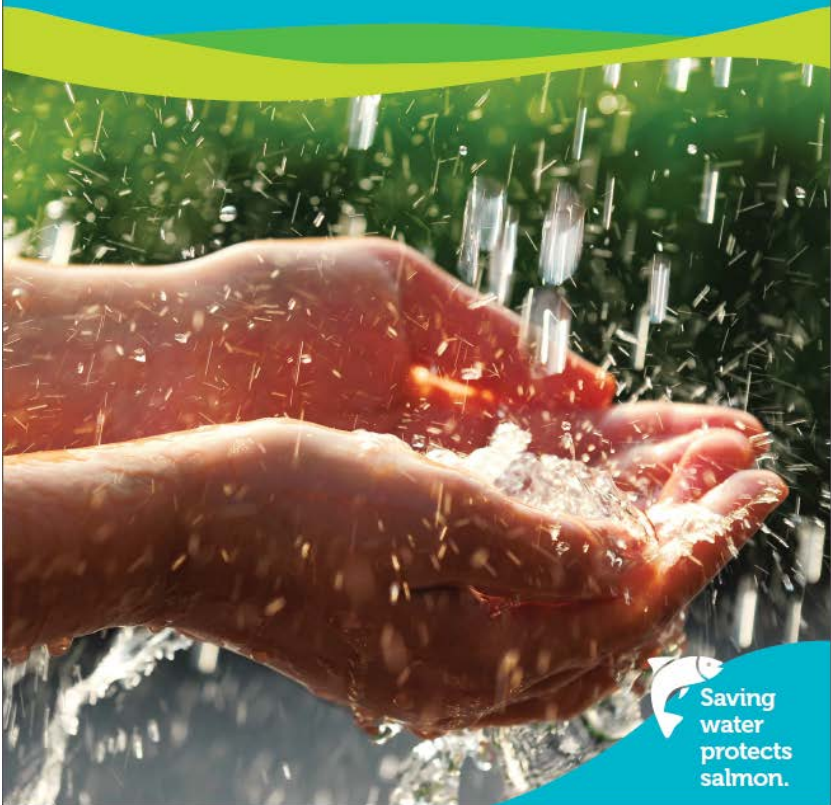

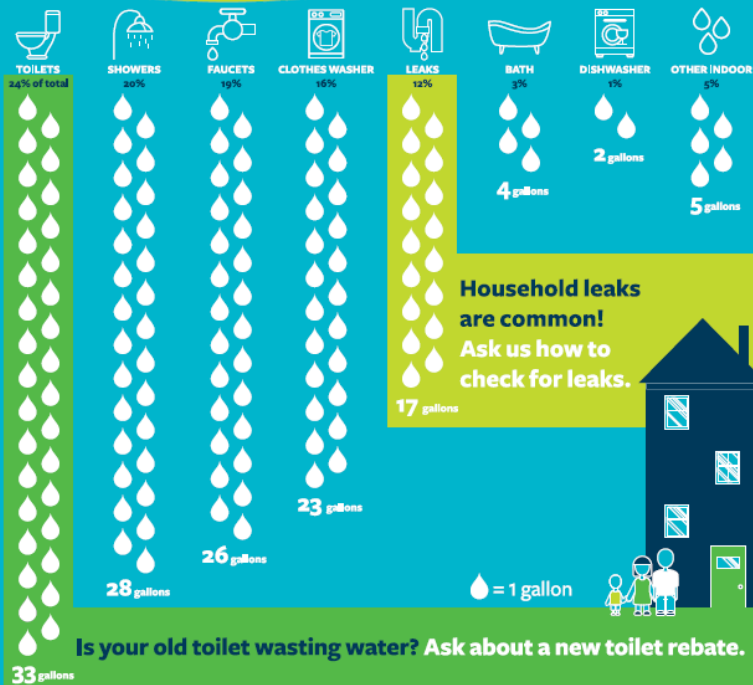

## Leaks

Some leaks are silent but costly.  
Test your toilet today.



1 Remove the toilet tank lid.



2 Put food coloring in the tank.



3 Don't flush. Wait 10 minutes.



4 Look in the bowl. If you see dye color in the bowl you have a leak.

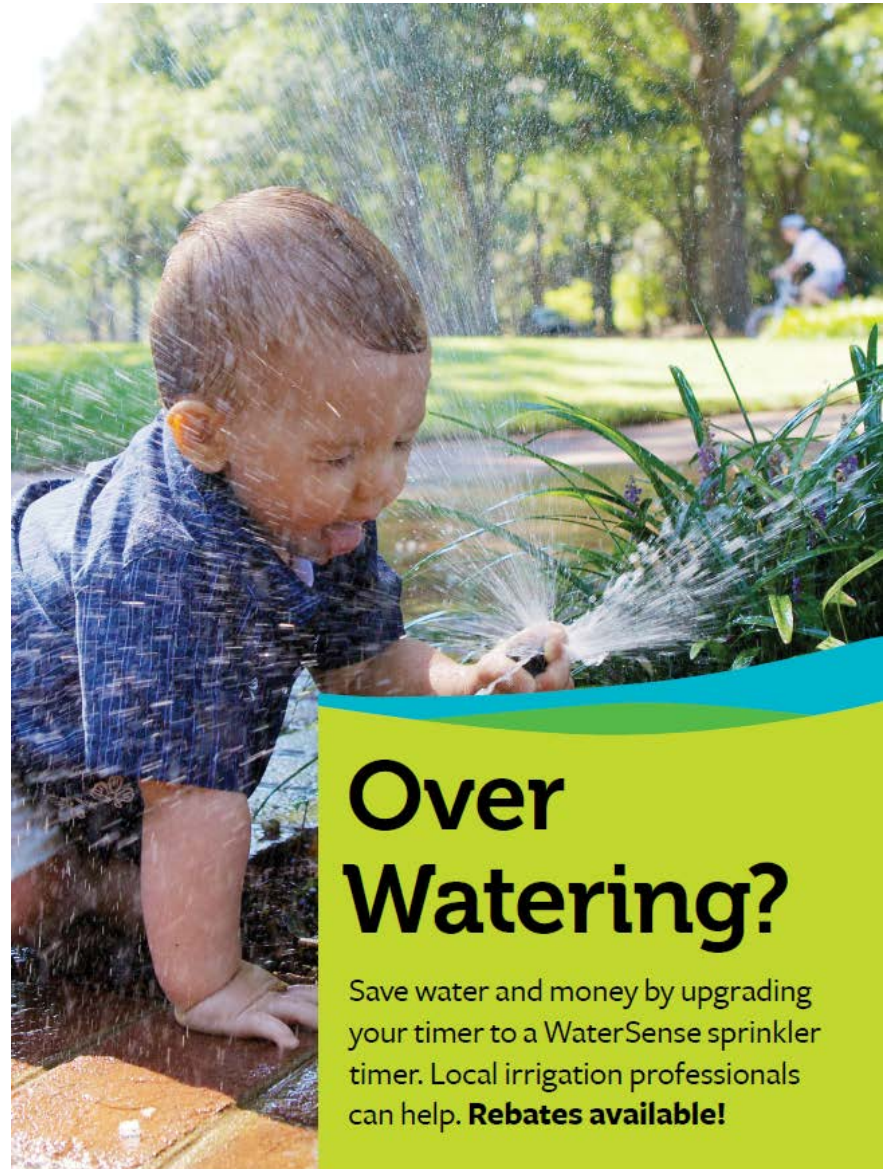

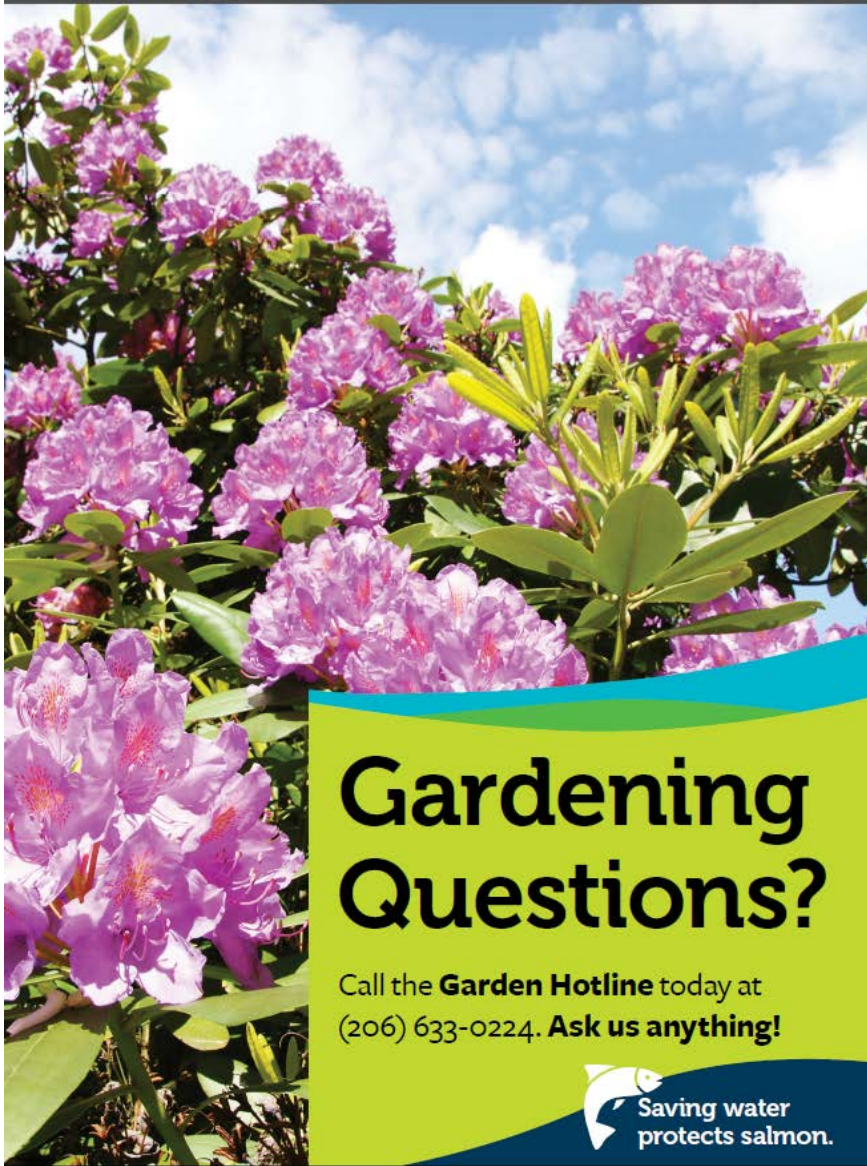
