Genesee Combined Sewer Overflow Reduction Project Roadway work after Seafair

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

As work on the two combined sewer overflow storage tanks nears completion we would like to provide details about the work that our contractor will perform after Seafair. Work will include installation of new underground structures and pipes in the streets to connect the storage tanks to the sewer system. Affected roadways will be fully restored.

A detailed description of the work locations and sequence is printed on the opposite side of this page.

SCHEDULE

Work is expected to begin the week of August 18. Major work is expected to be complete by late September with final restoration in the parking lot area during October. Normal work hours will be 7 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday through Friday. Work on will take place only as needed to stay on schedule. We will make every effort not to work on Saturdays.
