Genesee Combined Sewer Overflow Reduction Project Paving on Lake Washington Blvd. S.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Seattle Public Utilities' contractor plans to pave Lake Washington Blvd. S. at 49th Ave. S. on October 30 and 31. The contractor will close and pave one lane each day with flaggers directing traffic. Flaggers will be present throughout the night while the concrete cures, requiring lights for driver and worker safety. The contractor has chosen a fast-hardening concrete that will shorten the overall construction schedule. The contractor will not perform work at night.

In early November the contractor will begin to restore 49th Ave. S between Lake Washington Blvd S. and S. Dakota St. This includes restoring concrete panels in the roadway, the intersection at S. Dakota St. and sidewalks, curbs and driveways.

SCHEDULE

October 30 and 31, **7:00 a.m.-6:00 p.m.**: Daytime paving on Lake Washington Blvd. S.

October 30 and 31, **6:00 p.m.-7:00 a.m.**: Concrete hardens overnight.

Early November – mid-December: Roadway restoration.

November 7-14 (approximate dates): Concrete pouring. No driveway access on 49th Ave. S.

LOCATION

49th Ave. S. between Lake Washington Blvd. S. and S. Dakota St.

ANTICIPATED IMPACTS

- Lane closures on Lake Washington Blvd. S.
- Construction lights and generators
- Construction noise and dust
- Pavement excavation and restoration
- Restricted driving access to some houses
- Traffic detours

We will work directly with residents on 49th Ave. S. to arrange garbage, mail, and other logistics.
