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Background

The Projects Delivery Branch in Seattle Public Utilities (SPU) is planning to perform over \$170M worth of Capital Improvement Projects (CIP) work in 2015. The Project Controls & Performance Management Office (PC&PMO) supports projects delivery with cost engineering, planning, scheduling and performance monitoring on various projects. PC&PMO also sets standards and processes for consistent project and portfolio tracking, control and reporting for 70+ ongoing projects in SPU.

Project Scope

PC&PMO will hire one or more consultants to provide project controls services on specific capital projects or programs. Among the major projects/programs include: Combined Sewer Overflow (CSO) program; multiple water reservoirs seismic improvements; utility relocates in Alaskan Way Viaduct and Seattle Seawall; building new solid waste facilities; etc.

Project Controls consultant will work within PC&PMO defined processes and standards to develop projects baseline, update schedule and budget, forecast project cost and cash-flow, develop performance indices and provide reports. Project control consultant may also provide assistance in enhancing or integrating systems and processes for project delivery.
