

EMERGENCY WESTERN AVENUE WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT PROJECT

Construction update for October 3 – 9


Emergency work continues on Western Avenue to replace a water main at risk of failure. From October 3 – 9, you can expect the following impacts in the project area:

CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

- Work will continue on Western Avenue between Yesler Way and Marion Street Monday through Saturday during daytime hours.
- Installing new pipe and backfilling between Yesler Way and Columbia Street.
- Sawcutting, excavating and installing new pipe between Columbia and Marion Streets with increased noise and dust.
- Some night work is expected next week, with the noisiest work completed by 10 p.m. each night.
- A temporary weekend closure of the intersection at Western Avenue and Marion Street is expected in the coming weeks. More details will be provided prior to the closure.

ACCESS AND PARKING

- Western Avenue between Marion Street and Yesler Way will be closed to vehicle traffic from 6 a.m. – 3 p.m. One southbound lane will be open from 3 p.m. – 6 a.m.
- Large vehicles travelling southbound on Western Avenue should detour at Marion or Madison streets.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained between Yesler Way and Spring Street. Sidewalks may be closed at times to safely accommodate work next to the walkway.
- No on-street parking between Yesler Way and Marion Street.
- Steel plates may be present in the roadway. Bicyclists should use extreme caution.
