

NOTICE OF TRAFFIC IMPACT


Marion Street intersection closed at Western Avenue
Saturday, October 10, 6 a.m. – Monday, October 12, 5 a.m.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

Seattle Public Utilities (SPU) is replacing a 20-inch water main along Western Avenue that is at risk of failure. Construction is taking place between Yesler Way and Spring Street. This weekend, Marion Street will be closed to through traffic between Post and Western avenues from 6 a.m. on Saturday, October 10 to 5 a.m. on Monday, October 12 to perform work in the intersection of Western Avenue. Local access will be provided.

WHAT TO EXPECT:

- Intersection closed to vehicle traffic at Western Avenue and Marion Street. Detours available eastbound at Spring Street and westbound at Yesler Way.
- One southbound lane of traffic will remain open on Western Avenue between Spring Street and Yesler Way. Traffic may be stopped or detoured intermittently to accommodate work.
- Local access will be provided on Marion Street as needed. Please follow the directions of uniformed police officers.
- Work will occur 24 hours per day over the weekend, with the noisiest work ending by 10 p.m. each night.
- Some low lighting may be used in the work zone at night.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained. Please observe signs and follow the directions of crew members.
