

EMERGENCY WESTERN AVENUE WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT PROJECT

Construction update for October 24 to 30


Emergency work continues on Western Avenue to replace a water main at risk of failure. From October 24 to 30, you can expect the following impacts in the project area:

CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

- Work will occur from Columbia to Marion streets during the day Monday through Saturday.
- Work will include sawcutting, excavating and installing new pipe between Columbia and Marion streets with increased noise and dust.
- Restoration work may occur between Yesler Way and Columbia Street.
- Some night work is expected next week, with the noisiest work completed by 10 p.m. each night.

ACCESS AND PARKING

- Western Avenue between Madison and Columbia streets will be closed to vehicle traffic from 6 a.m. to 3 p.m.
- One southbound lane will be open on Western Avenue from 3 p.m. to 6 a.m. with some intermittent closures to accommodate work.
- Large vehicles should detour to avoid Western Avenue between Madison Street and Yesler Way.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained between Yesler Way and Spring Street. Some intermittent sidewalk closures may be needed to accommodate work.
- No on-street parking between Madison and Columbia streets.
- Steel plates may be present in the roadway. Bicyclists should use extreme caution.
