Notice of Rule Revision

Under the authority of the Seattle Municipal Code 3.02.030 and 3.32.020, notice is hereby given for revisions to a Director's Rule of Seattle Public Utilities (SPU). The SPU Director proposes to revise SW-402.1 "Prohibition of Recyclables in Garbage" to include the following substantive amendments:

- Extending the period of educational notices, as related to significant amounts of food waste and compostable paper in garbage containers, from June 30, 2015 to December 31, 2015
- Delaying implementation of collection fees, for significant amounts of food waste and compostable paper in garbage containers, from July 1, 2015 to January 1, 2015
- Applying these new notice and fee timelines, as described above, across customer segments.
- Confirming that disputes and appeals to these collection fees will be handled through standard SPU policies and procedures.
