Gentlemen,

We have been informed that your Honorable
.committee acting on a petition presented to you by ourselves seeking to
obtain certain privileges and rights in the sale of our wares and
the promotion of our amusements in our booths fronting on the streets
and avenues, leading to the A. Y. P. Exposition, determined and
decided that we ought to ^{be} awarded in a moderate degree the concessions
we requested in the said petition. We were informed that the Chief
of Police would be apprised of the opinion of your committee and
would be instructed to allow certain privileges and show a certain
amount of leniency.

In view of the information we take this liberty of
informing this Honorable committee that the condition of affairs and
the strict, unbearable attitude of the police has not changed a
single bit and that neither the officers nor sergeants in this
district have received any instructions from headquarters to allow
any privileges and show any leniency.

We beg to state to this committee that our condition is
as objectionable and as unbearable as before this Honorable committee
passed on our petition and we respectfully submit that if this
committee were satisfied that greater leniency should be shown
by the police that the patrolmen and officers ought to abide by
the determination of this committee and we ask that you cause
your instructions to be carried into effect so that our condition
may be alleviated.
