ORDINANCE NO. 69252

AN ORDINANCE relating to the construction of a viaduct and approaches thereto on East 45th Street, increasing the appropriation therefor, and amending Section 2 of Ordinance No. 65329.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 65329, entitled:

"AN ORDINANCE relating to and providing for the construction of a viaduct and approaches thereto on East 45th Street, east of 18th Avenue Northeast connecting with Montlake Boulevard east of 25th Avenue Northeast, and appropriating money therefor,"

approved on the 29th Day of August, 1935, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2. That the sum of Two Hundred Eight Thousand and No/100 Dollars (\$208,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated from the City Street Fund for the purpose set forth in Section 1 hereof. The sum hereby appropriated shall include any moneys contributed by the Federal Emergency Administration of Public Works to aid this improvement, and such moneys when received shall be paid into said City Street Fund.

Section 2... This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.

Gentlemen:

I am submitting herewith for your approval Council Bill increasing the appropriation providing for the East 45th Street Viaduct by Ordinance No. 65622 from \$200,000.00 to \$208,000.00.

Approximately half of this increase is due to change in design demanded by the state highway department after the project had been advertised for bids. Ordinarily this additional money would not be required until the project was practically completed. This being a P.E.A. project, it becomes necessary to show that the City has sufficient funds to complete the project before the P.E.A. will honor our next requisition for funds, which we expect to make shortly.

This increase in cost does not increase the total expenditures anticipated from the City Street Fund because we expect to save approximately \$14,000.00 in the construction of the 24th Avenue Southwest paving project.
