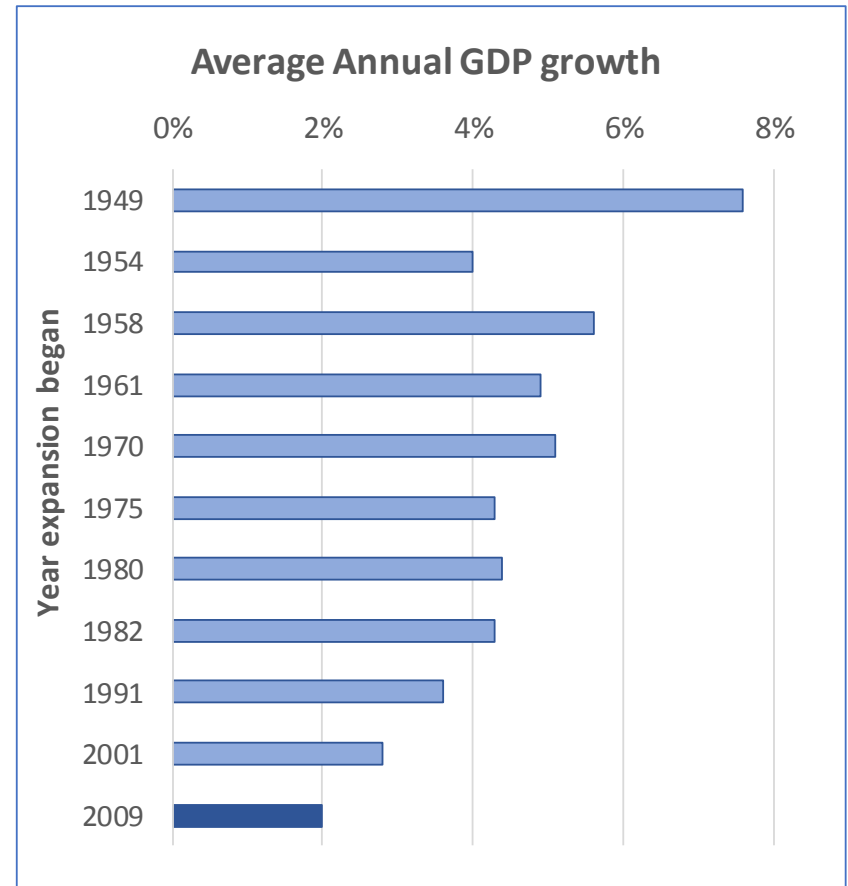
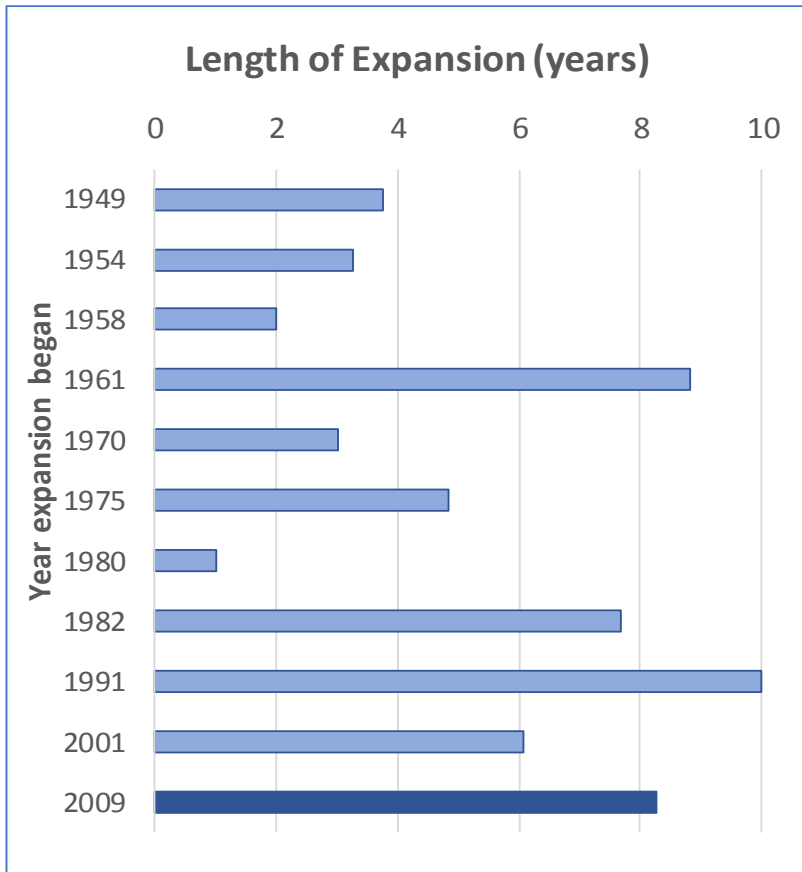

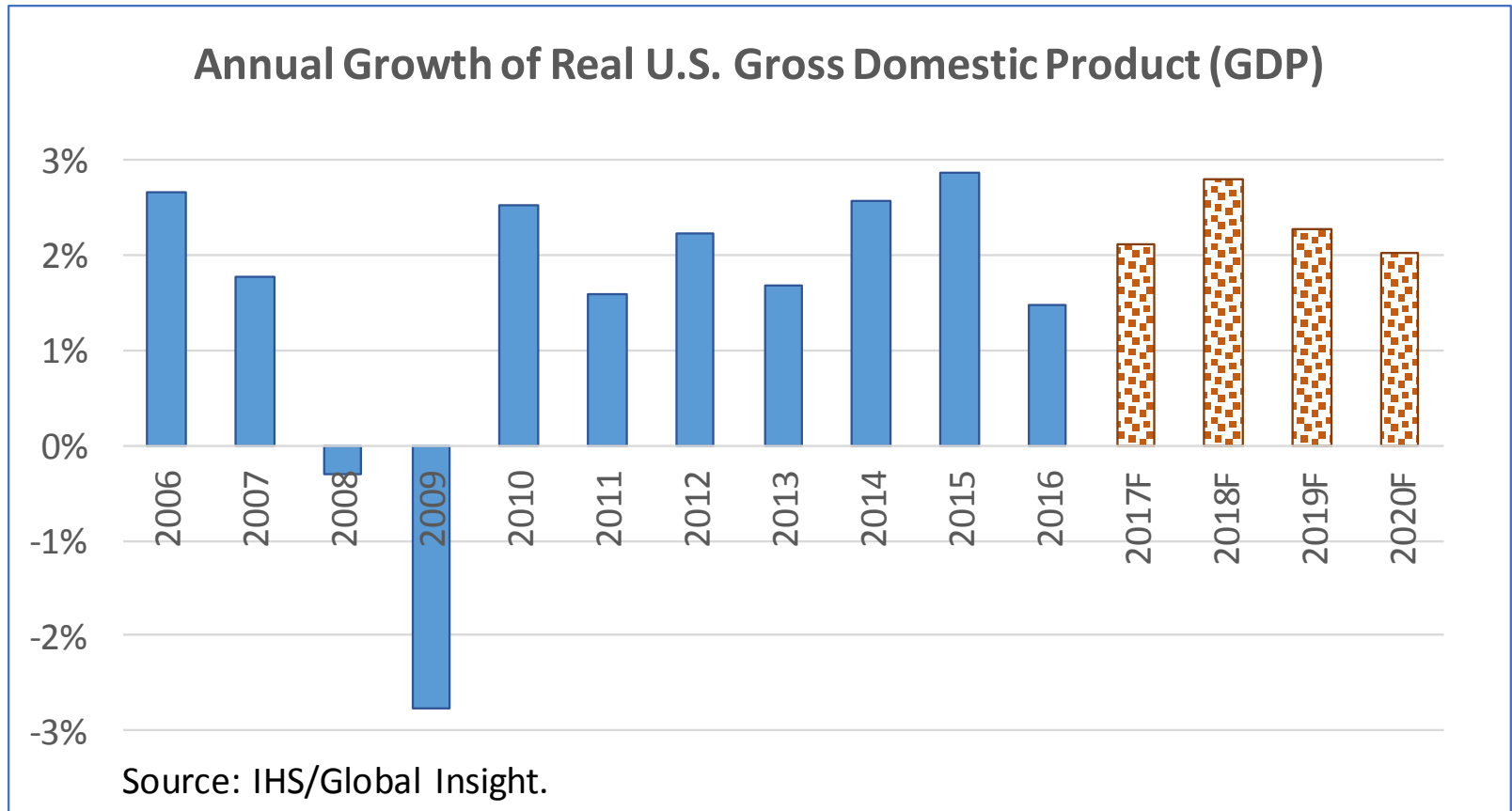
# U.S. Economy

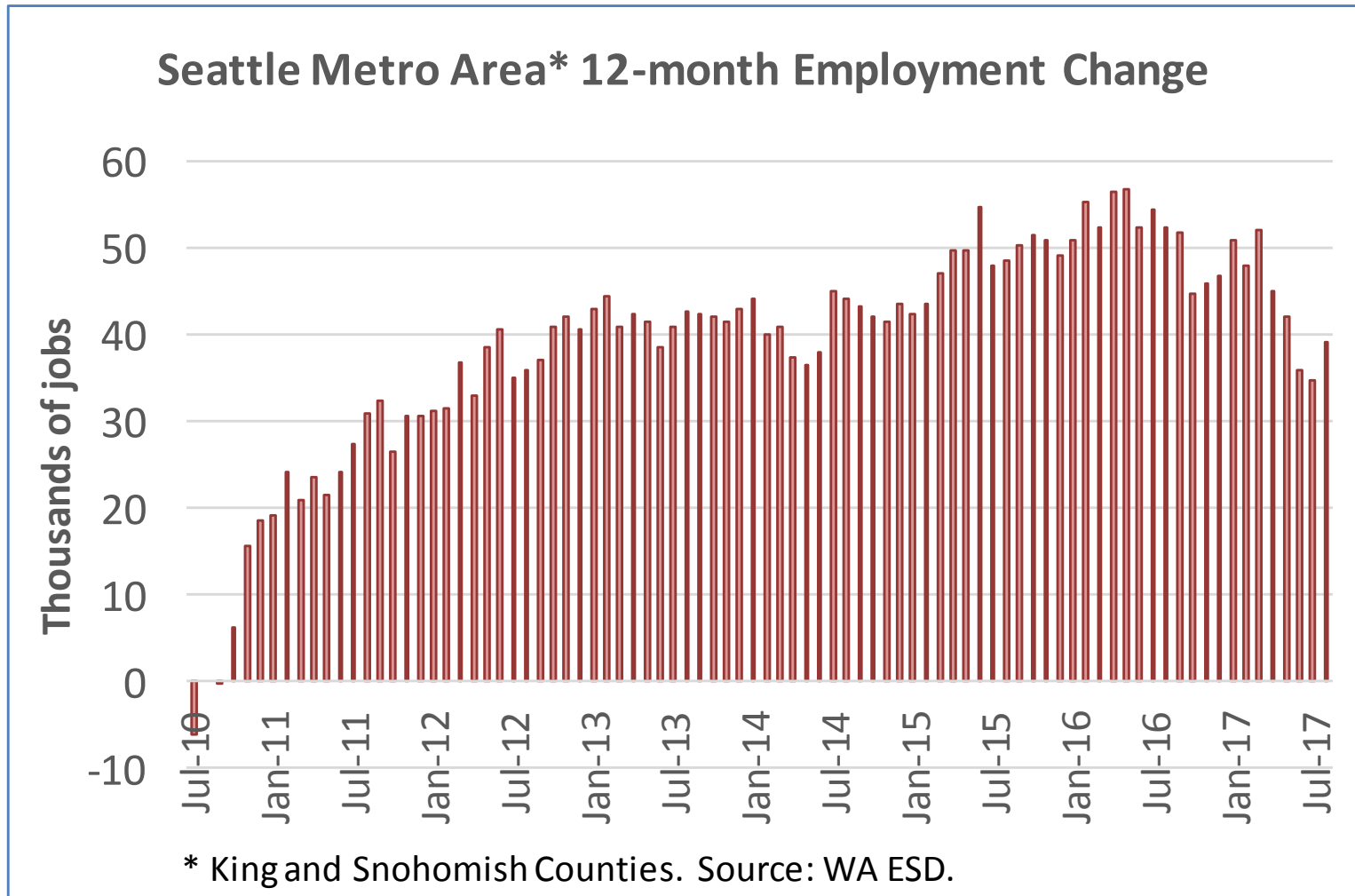
## The region's expansion

- Seattle has led region's expansion

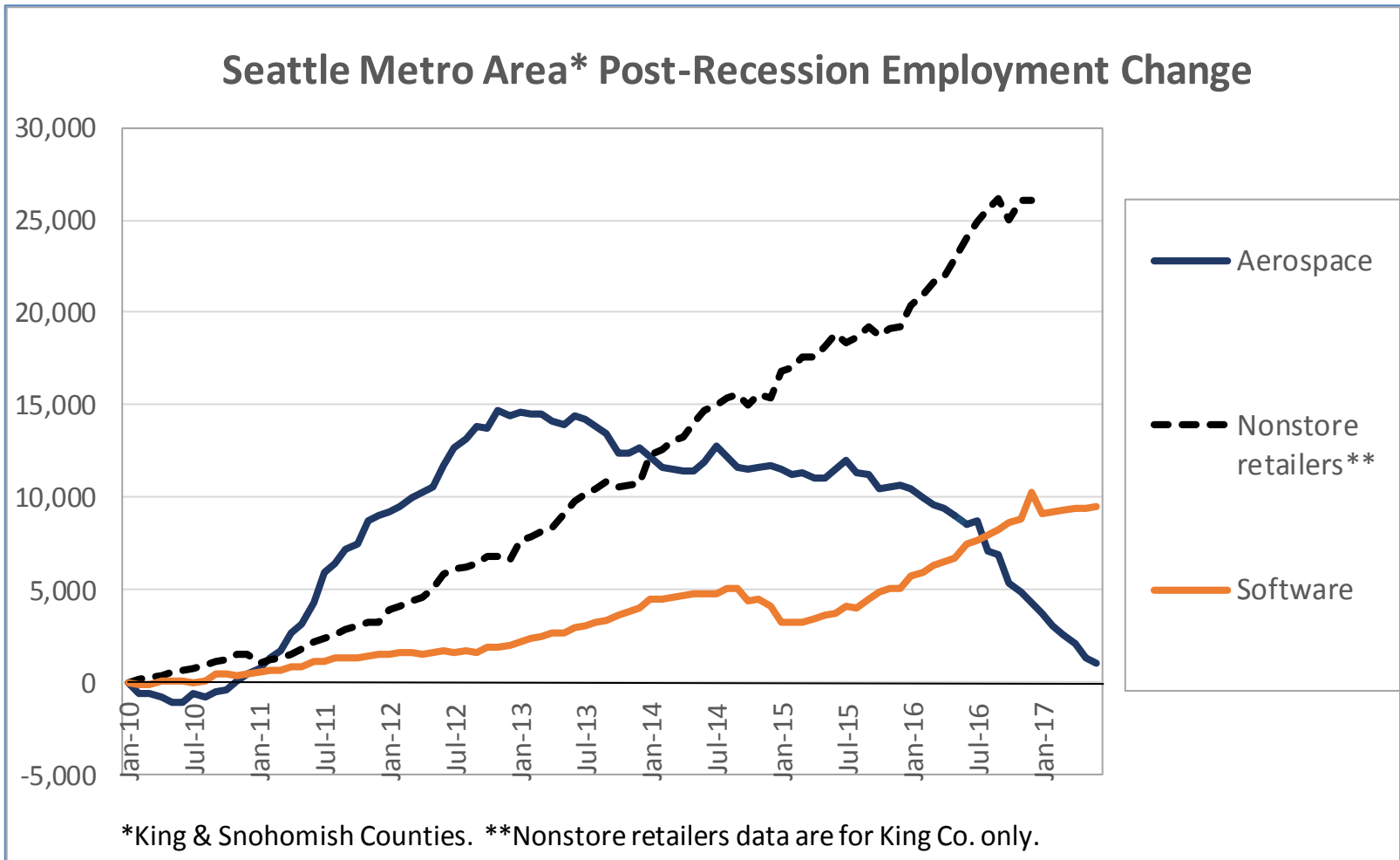
## Forecast

  - Construction

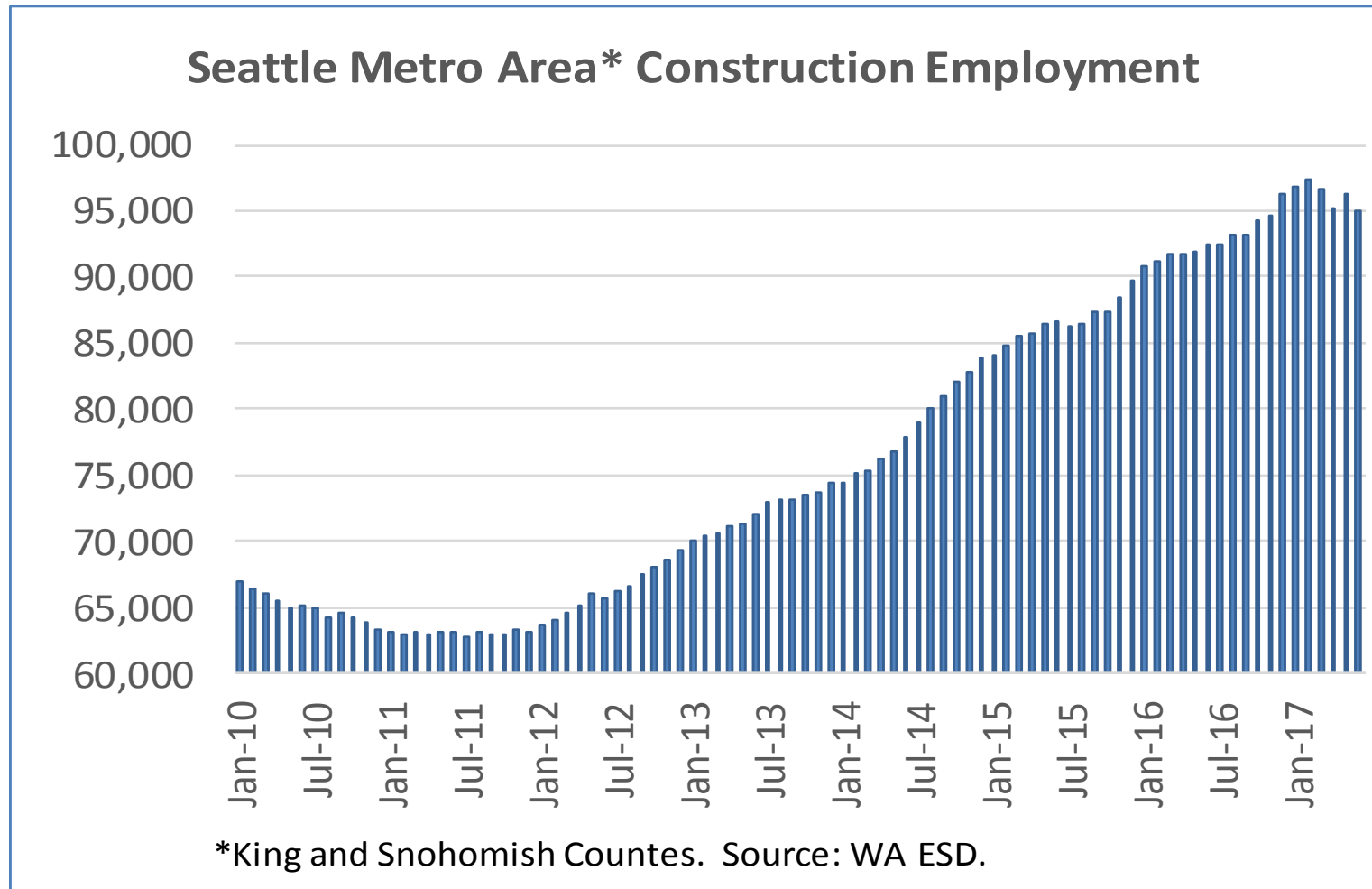

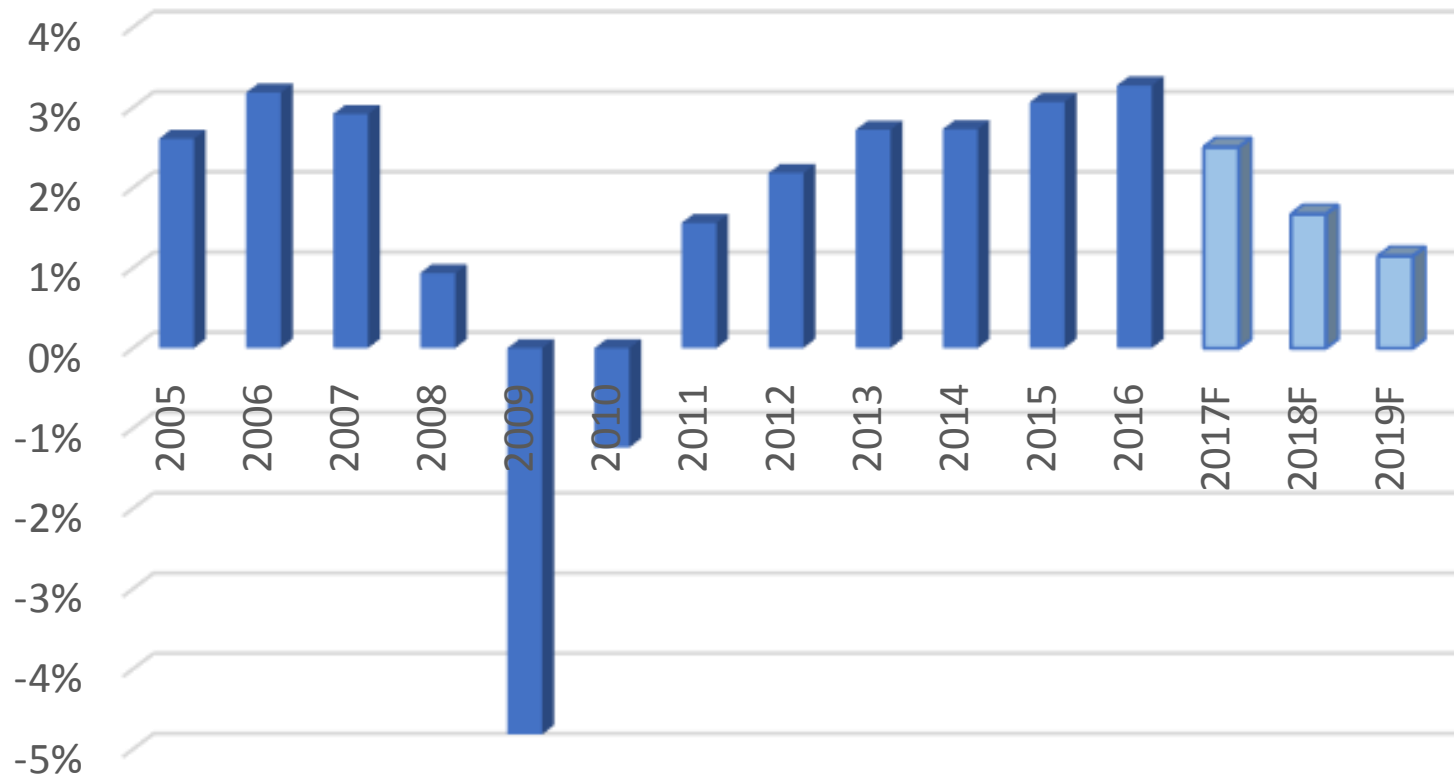

# Sales and B&O Tax

Revenue growth has been slowing since mid-2015

Forecast: more slowing

- Slowing regional economy
- Construction cycle
- Slowing will be partly offset by:
  - B&O tax rate increases
  - State expanding sales tax base
    - Bottled water added
    - Expanded taxation of remote sales

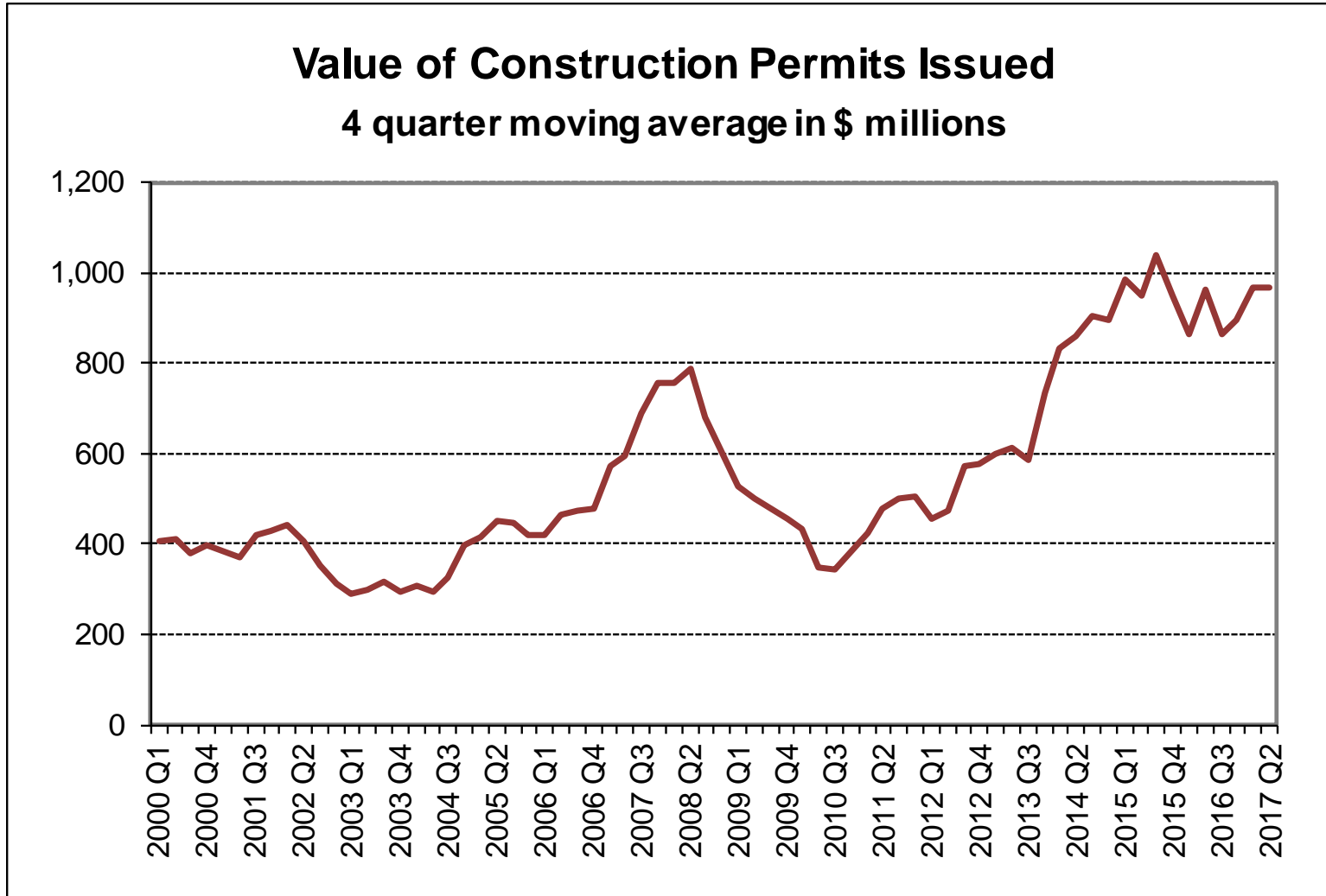

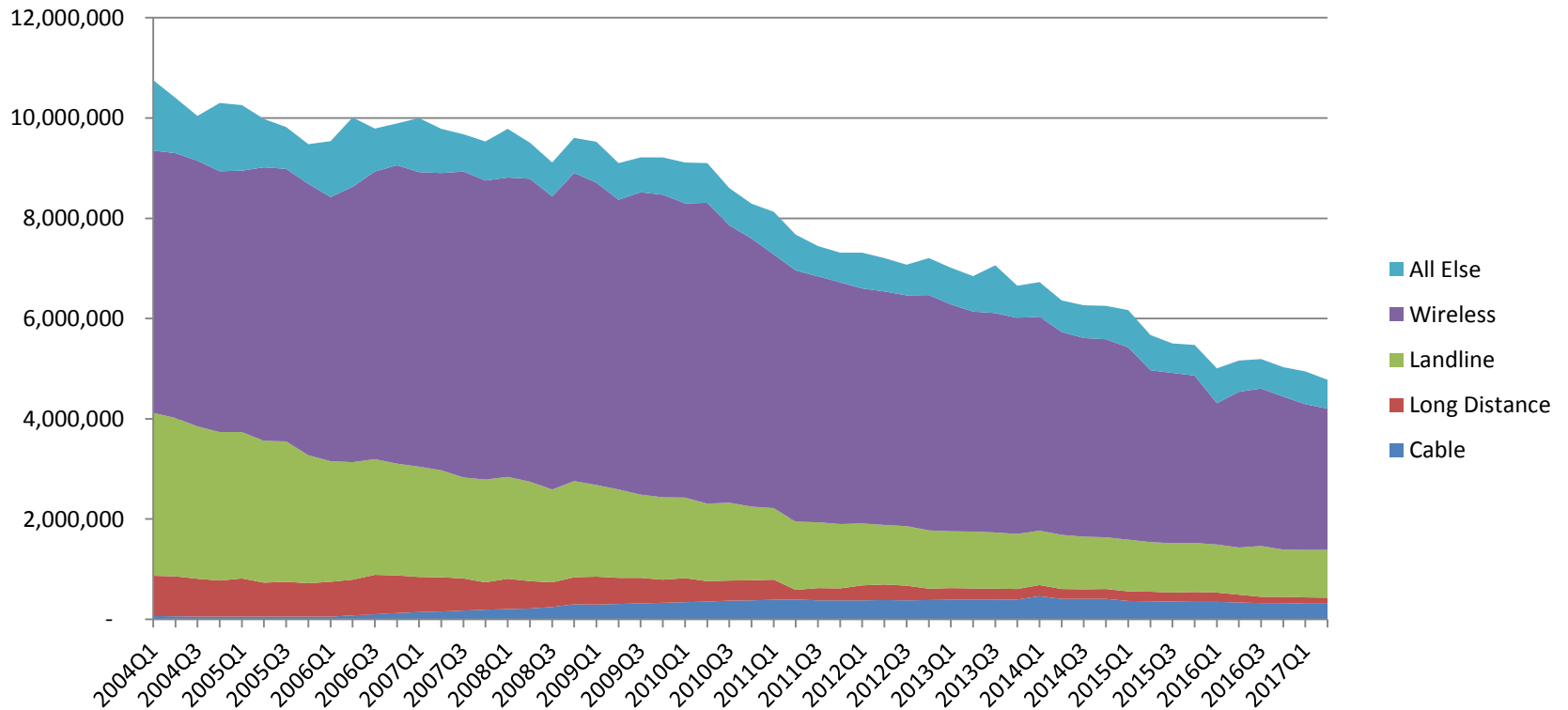

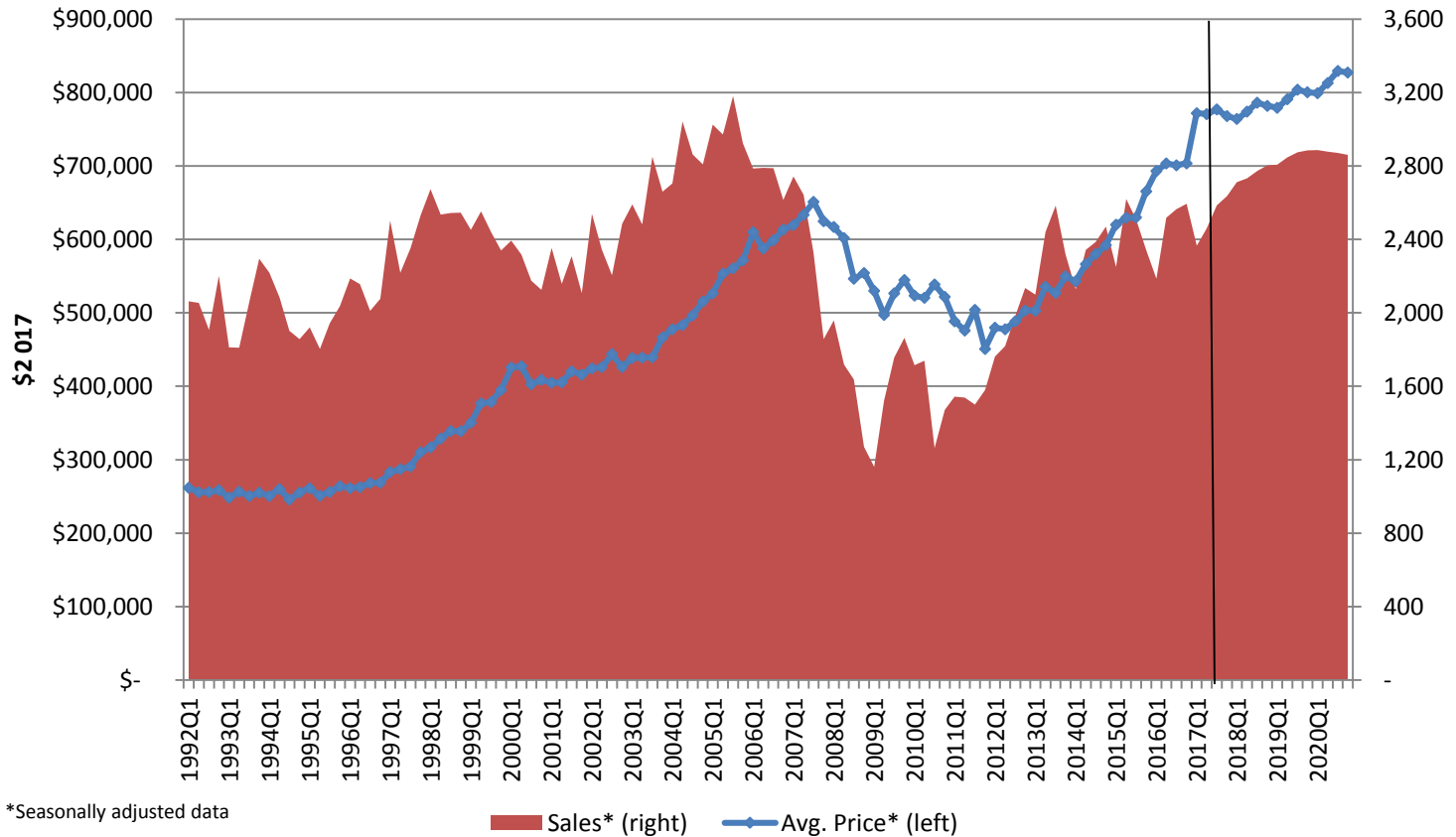

## Telecommunications Tax Obligations \$2017

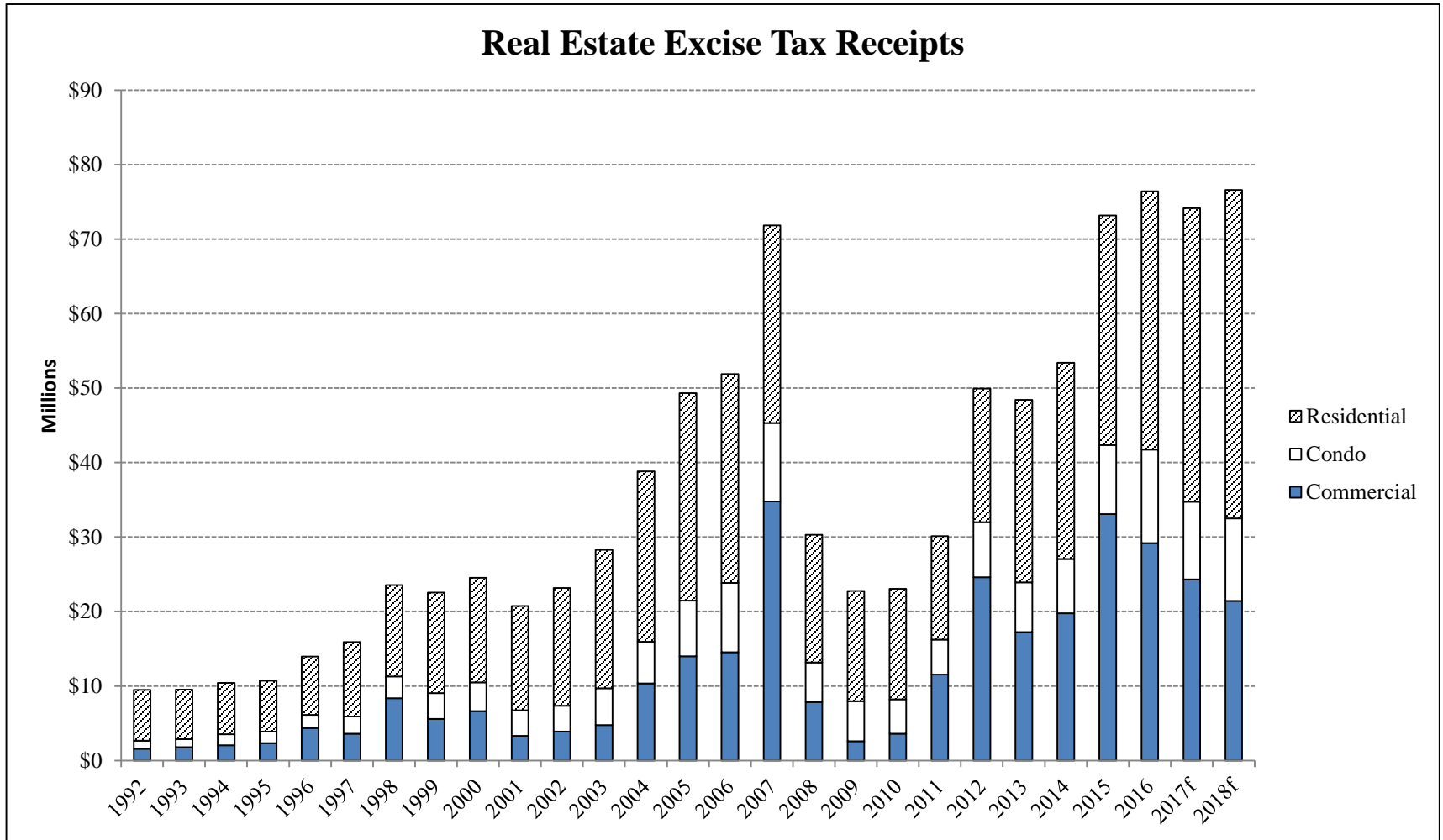
