21	I. <u>FINDING</u>	S OF FACT					
22	A. <u>Washington State Toxicology Labo</u>	oratory Actions.					
23	1. The Washington State Patrol Toxicology	Laboratory ("Tox Lab"), located at 2203					
24	Airport Way S, Suite 360, Seattle, WA, is used by the

1 under the influence of drugs or intoxicating liquors. The Tox Lab tests thousands of samples of blood per year.

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4	2. In March 2018, the Tox Lab expanded its testing into an office and lab workspace on
5	the same floor but separated by a hallway. This workspace, known as "the Annex," was
6	previously occupied by the Seattle Crime Laboratory from 2002 to 2018. Unbeknownst to the
7	Tox Lab when it expanded into the Annex, forensic scientists working for the WSP Clandestine
8	Lab Response Team had previously used the workspace to synthesize and study
9	methamphetamine for training purposes. Synthesis of methamphetamine occurred up to
10	approximately twenty times from 2002 to 2011. Def Ex D.
11	3. In November 2018, a blood sample tested for drugs in the Annex resulted in
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13	"discrepant" results: the first screening yielded presumptively positive results for meth, then a
14	second test came back negative. A third test confirmed negative. No cause for this discrepant
15	test was identified.
16	4. On June 5, 2019, the Tox Lab discovered a second false positive for meth in a test
17	conducted in the Annex. Def Ex. G.
18	5. On June 9, 2019, Hood 1 in the main lab was discontinued for use after six cases were
19	determined to have dimensioned and be

determined to have discrepant results.

6. From March 2018 to June 9, 2019, the Tox Lab identified nine cases with discrepant 21 results. Seven were related to death investigations; the remaining two involved blood obtained 22 via warrant from individuals arrested for allegedly driving under the influence of alcohol and/or 23 24 drugs ("DUI"). During this same period, the Tox Lab performed tests in 872 death investigation 25 cases, 2,857 DUI cases, and 103 other miscellaneous cases. Def. Exhibit H; City Ex. G. 26 111

7. On June 13, 2019, the Tox Lab collected samples from ten areas of the Main Lab, Annex and adjoining office spaces, and had them analyzed by Anatek, Inc., an environmental testing laboratory. On June 14, 2019, Anatek tested the samples. On June 17, 2019, the Tox Lab learned six of the ten test samples were positive for methamphetamine. Def Exhibit I.

8. On June 19, 2019, the Tox lab permanently stopped using the Annex to test blood samples.

9. On or about July 19, 2019, Tox Lab Manager Dr. Brianna Peterson conducted an online search to find a company that could test and clean the Annex and the Tox Lab. Dr. Peterson found a list of state certified decontamination companies on the Washington State Department of Health website. After eliminating companies that were either too busy to respond or were not located nearby, the Tox Lab contracted with Bio Clean on June 19, 2019, to test for contamination and offer solutions on how to clean it up. Initial testing of the Annex indicated the presence of methamphetamine on surfaces throughout the Annex including the lab, office space, ceiling fans, hallways, floors and a vestibule. In the Main Lab, Hood 1 tested positive for meth. Testimony and Def. Ex K.

10. On July 25, 2019, the Tox Lab disclosed possible methamphetamine contamination to the ANSI-ASQ Accreditation Board (ANAB). City Ex. R.

11. In November 2019, February 2020, and April 2020, Bio Clean took samples from different surfaces in the Main Lab and detected "high" levels of meth/cocaine contamination. Bio Clean also made attempts to clean lab surfaces and Hood No. 1. In May 2020, cleaning samples continued to test positive for contamination.

12. Miriam Norman is employed at the Seattle City Attorney's Office and also serves as a Traffic Safety Resource Prosecutor for the Washington Traffic Safety Commission ("WTSC").

On or about August 5, 2020, Ms. Norman learned of the contamination issue from a friend who worked as a staff member at the Tox Lab. <u>City Ex. C</u>. Ms. Norman advised the Tox Lab that it should report the possible contamination to WTSC and helped draft a Potential Impeachment Disclosure ("PID") letter.

13. On August 7, 2020, the Tox Lab issued a PID letter cosigned by Ms. Norman and 6 Pam Loginsky, a staff attorney at the Washington Association of Prosecuting Attorneys 7 8 ("WAPA"). The PID explained that there had been environmental contamination in portions of 9 the Tox Lab, noted the findings of methamphetamine in levels that exceeded the levels specified 10 in WAC 246-205-541, and stated "the environmental contamination possibly contaminated some 11 blood samples during the extraction process." Def. Ex C. The PID was sent to WAPA, the 12 Washington Association of Criminal Defense Lawyers ("WACDL") and the Washington 13 Defender Association ("WDA"). City Ex. B. 14

14. The WSP Tox Lab issued additional PIDs on September 3, 2020, March 11, 2021,
April 1, 2021, and May 7, 2021. <u>City Ex. G, I, J, L, M</u>. The Seattle City Attorney's Office issued
a PID on March 12, 2021. <u>City Ex. K</u>.

15. On August 19, 2020, Ms. Loginsky sent an email to WAPA Felony Traffic and WAPA District Court providing a list of cases that may have been "most directly impacted by the environmental contamination." <u>City Ex. G</u>. An updated Discrepant Results Case List was issued on October 27, 2021. <u>City Ex. H</u>.

23 16. On August 25, 2020, the Tox Lab issued a Q&A related to the methamphetamine
24 contamination in the lab. On December 7, 2020, the Q&A was revised. Def Ex. H.

17. In January 2021, March 2021 and April 2021, the Tox Lab discovered three more cases with discrepant results for methamphetamine, bringing the total number of cases with discrepant results to twelve. <u>City Ex. H</u>.

18. On January 4, 2021, the Tox Lab noted the tenth discrepant result. While the other eleven discrepant results involved an initial positive methamphetamine result followed by a negative result and a confirmed negative, the tenth involved inconsistent positive results. The initial screening results indicated methamphetamine was >1.0 mg/L, but the subsequent test came back with a result much lower: .031 mg/L. A retest confirmed the second result. To confirm the correct amount, the Tox Lab sent the unopened B vial to an outside lab, NMS Labs. In a report dated February 1, 2021, NMS reported a methamphetamine result in agreement with the in-house second and third tests. Def Ex. X, pages 695-699, 801-805.

19. Throughout 2020 and the first quarter of 2021, the Tox Lab continued to have Bio
Clean sample and clean various parts of the Main Lab. On March 16, 2021, Bio Clean found
contamination near Hoods 5 and 6. <u>Def Ex. S</u>.

20. On May 31, 2021, as part of a study conducted by the National Institute for Standards and Technology ("NIST") related to background levels of drugs found in forensic science labs, samples were taken throughout the Main Lab and sent to the NIST for testing. NIST reported methamphetamine in four areas of the lab. <u>Def. Ex V</u>.

21. On July 15, 2021, the areas with positive results were cleaned by laboratory
personnel, and additional NIST tests were planned. <u>Def. Ex. V</u>.

22. On December 9, 2021, NIST provided the results from the analysis of 25 samples collected from the Main Lab on October 28, 2021. The report concluded: "From the 25 samples

provided, none were found to have quantifiable levels of any of the 29 drugs included in the LC-MS/MS panel, and no compounds of interest were detected in any of the samples." Def Ex CC.

23. Per Dr. Peterson, due to the Tox Lab's system of confirmatory testing, no toxicology reports issued during the time of the contamination went out with false results.

24. Although several witnesses speculated that the source of the meth contamination in the Annex and the Main Lab was due to the synthesizing of meth by the Crime Lab from 2007-2011, no evidence was provided to directly prove or disprove this theory.

25. The ANAB has not sanctioned the WSP Tox Lab or sought to revoke its certification due to the discovery of methamphetamine contamination in the Annex or the Main Lab. The ANAB has continued to approve the Tox Lab's procedures.

26. Of the twelve discrepant tests identified by the Tox Lab, none involve the named defendants in the three Seattle Municipal Court cases subject to this motion. <u>City Ex. H</u>. Of the twelve discrepant results, eleven were reported out as negative results. The twelfth was the only positive test, and it was confirmed by an outside lab.

27. When an individual is arrested for DUI and their blood is drawn pursuant to search warrant, two separate vials of blood are taken. <u>Defense Ex. B</u>, pp. 000027, 000058, 000115. The Tox Lab tests the blood in Vial A. Vial B remains available to be tested separately.

1	i. On October 7, 2021, the parties agreed to reschedule the en banc motion							
2	hearing for January 12, 2022. The trial date was continued by agreement of the parties.							
3	j. On January 12-14, 2022, the en banc motion hearing was held. At the end of the							
4	hearing, the parties agreed to schedule the jury trial for March 15, 2022.							
6	4. During the en banc motion hearing, no evidence was introduced to establish the							
7	toxicology test results in these three cases were inaccurate or invalid.							
8	II. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW							
9	A. <u>CrRLJ 8.3(b) Does Not Warrant Dismissal of the Defendants' Cases.</u>							
10	The defendants have asked this court to dismiss their cases, citing CrRLJ 8.3(b). Under							
11	CrRLJ 8.3(b), the party seeking relief "bears the burden of showing both misconduct and							
12 13	prejudice." State v. Salgado-Mendoza, 189 Wn.2d 420, 427 (2017). In Washington, the general							
13	approach to discovery violations is to impose the least severe constian that adapted a discovery							
15	the prejudice. In order to warrant the extraordinary remedy of dismissal, the prejudice must rise							
16	to the level that it materially affects the defendant's right to a fair trial. Salgado-Mendoza, 189							
17	Wn.2d at 432.							
18	Although the language of the rule itself refers only to dismissal of charges, Washington							
19	courts have interpreted the rule to allow lesser remedies such as suppression or continuance.							
20	See, CrRLJ 8.3(b); Salgado-Mendoza, 189 Wn.2d at 430-31; City of Seattle v. Holifield, 170							
21 22	Wn.2d 230, 239 (2010). "Dismissal 'is an extraordinary remedy, one which a trial court should							
23	turn to only as a last resort. " Holifield, 170 Wn.2d at 237 (emphasis in original). Trial courts							
24	should consider "intermediate remedial steps" before ordering the extraordinary remedy of							
25	dismissal. Id. "We have stated unequivocally that '[d]ismissal is unwarranted in cases where							
26	suppression of evidence may eliminate whatever prejudice is caused by governmental

misconduct." Id. (citing State v. Marks, 114 Wn.2d 724, 730 (1990)). "This is consistent with the general approach to discovery violations, encouraging courts to impose the least severe sanction that adequately addresses the prejudice." Salgado-Mendoza, 189 Wn.2d at 431.

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## 1. Defendants Have Demonstrated Government Misconduct in the Form of Mismanagement.

6 CrRLJ 8.3(b) analysis necessarily starts with a determination about whether 7 "governmental misconduct" has occurred. The misconduct "need not be of an evil or dishonest 8 nature, simple mismanagement is enough." State v. Brooks, 149 Wn. App. 373, 384 (2009). 9 Misconduct or mismanagement may justify dismissal or a lesser remedy such as suppression. 10 regardless of what part of government is responsible for the misconduct. For example, courts 11 12 have found misconduct attributable to prosecuting attorneys (Salgado-Mendoza, 189 Wn.2d 420 13 (late disclosure of identity of witness)), toxicology labs (Holifield, 179 Wn.2d 230 (upholding 14 trial court's remedy of suppression for toxicology lab misconduct)), court administration (State 15 v. Jieta, 12 Wn. App. 2d 227 (2020)); jail officers (State v. Garza, 99 Wn. App. 291 (2000) 16 (reviewing attorney-client communications seized from defendants' jail cells)) and other government bodies.

In this consolidated case, the defendants have demonstrated several areas of 19 20 mismanagement by the Tox Lab.

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### Continued Testing in the Main Lab Was Mismanagement. a.

This court concludes that the primary form of mismanagement proved by the defendants is the continued testing of biological samples for the presence of drugs in a laboratory known to be contaminated with methamphetamine. The Tox Lab became aware of possible contamination in the Annex as early as June 2019. The Anatek lab testing performed on June 13, 2019,

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revealed methamphetamine contamination in the Annex, offices connected to the Annex, and in Hood 1 in the Main Lab.

Bio Clean was contracted to sample and clean-up any contamination in the Annex and Main Lab. Their preliminary testing of the Annex and Main Lab on June 13, 2019, confirmed areas of methamphetamine contamination throughout the lab. Despite the fact methamphetamine contamination was found in the Main Lab (Hood 1), the Tox Lab continued to conduct testing in the Main Lab.

Bio Clean's post-decontamination samples, in April and May 2020, showed continued methamphetamine contamination in the lab areas, including in the ceiling vents. Additional discrepant results were observed or discovered in January 2021 and March 2021. Samples taken by Bio Clean during this period revealed areas of contamination near Hood 6. Nevertheless, the Tox Lab continued to conduct testing in the Main Lab during this period.

As part of a NIST study related to background contamination in forensic science facilities, the Tox Lab sampled various areas of the Main Lab on May 31,2021. Several of the samples came back positive for methamphetamine. While additional cleanup efforts were made, the Tox Lab continued to conduct testing in the lab.

Another round of samples were taken for the NIST study on October 28, 2021. None of these samples identified any areas of methamphetamine contamination.

Conducting forensic testing of blood samples in the Main Lab from June 2019 to October 28, 2021, when the contamination continued to be present, constitutes mismanagement. All of the witnesses who testified at the *en banc* hearing agreed that the practice of using discrepant results to identify whether contamination occurred would be ineffective if *the original evidence sample* was contaminated. Therefore, the Tox Lab committed mismanagement by continuing to

test in an area where they would not be able to identify whether their initial sample was contaminated.

The Tox Lab could have mitigated or accounted for this mismanagement by confirming any methamphetamine positive blood samples. The lab could have sent the second, unopened blood sample to an outside lab to confirm their results, as they did in February 2021 with the tenth discrepant result. When the Tox Lab's testing was completed in an area with known contamination, failure to confirm positive meth results by testing Vial B at an outside lab, also constitutes mismanagement.

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## Delayed Disclosure of the Contamination to Prosecutors or Defense b. Attorneys Constitutes Mismanagement.

The second form of mismanagement proven by the defendants is the Tox Lab's failure to disclose the fact of contamination and the discrepant results to prosecutors and defense attorneys as potential impeachment information.

From June 2019 until the first PID was issued on August 7, 2020, the Tox Lab committed 16 mismanagement by not disclosing the contamination to anyone other than their accrediting 17 agency, ANAB. Witnesses from the Tox Lab testified that they were unaware of this duty to 18 disclose. It is unclear who or what agency had the obligation to adequately train or inform the 19 20 toxicologists about this obligation. Nevertheless, the obligation existed and was breached by the 21 non-disclosure.

After the initial PID, the Tox Lab has demonstrated efforts to comply with these 23 disclosure requirements by issuing additional PIDs and by maintaining a website with updated information about the contamination event and any discrepant results. The defendants have argued these disclosures are misleading or incomplete. However, this court finds the disclosures were not intentionally incomplete or deficient. All Tox Lab witnesses testified that the

likelihood of contamination of the original evidence was unlikely. They did not view this as a reasonable possibility. The court concludes the omission of this information in the PIDs was a result of their scientific judgment rather than any desire to conceal or mislead.

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# <u>Defendants Have Failed to Demonstrate Prejudice That Would Warrant</u> <u>Dismissal Under CrRLJ 8.3(b).</u>

6 A finding of mismanagement or misconduct on the part of the government is not enough 7 to warrant dismissal of a case under CrRLJ 8.3(b). The rule itself provides that dismissal may 8 only occur "when there has been prejudice to the rights of the accused which materially affect 9 the accused's right to a fair trial." CrRLJ 8.3(b). Dismissal is an extreme remedy and should be 10 used "only as a last resort." State v. Wilson, 149 Wash 2d 1, 12 (2003). The level of misconduct 11 12 needed to warrant dismissal "must shock the conscience of the court and the universal sense of 13 fairness." State v. Martinez, 121 Wn. App. 21, 35 (2004). The Washington Supreme Court has 14 ruled that dismissal is not warranted in cases where the suppression of evidence may eliminate 15 whatever prejudice is caused by governmental misconduct. State v. Marks, 114 Wn.2d 724, 730 16 (1990). 17

For example, in <u>State v. Martinez</u>, the Court of Appeals upheld the dismissal of a case under CrR 8.3(b) when the State withheld material, exculpatory evidence from the defense until partway through trial. 121 Wn. App. 21 (2004). In <u>State v. Michielli</u>, the Supreme Court upheld the dismissal of charges when the State added the charges only five days before the trial, without any supporting justification for the late amendment. 132 Wn.2d 229 (1997).

Washington courts have emphasized that "speculative prejudice" is not enough; a
defendant must show "actual prejudice" in order to justify dismissal. <u>State v. Rohrich</u>, 149 Wn.
2d 647 (2003). In <u>Rohrich</u>, the appellate court overturned a dismissal where the basis for the
prejudice was simply that memories "*could have*" faded or that defendant's own power of

recollection "could have been compromised" is insufficient to show actual prejudice. 149 Wn. 2d at 657.

In the instant cases, the defendants have failed to demonstrate actual prejudice to their cases that would warrant the extraordinary remedy of dismissal. Their claims of prejudice essentially fall into two categories: 1) the possibility of unreliable evidence being used to convict them; and 2) being forced to choose between their speedy trial rights and effective assistance of counsel.

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## Defendants Have Failed to Demonstrate the Results of Their 2. Blood Tests Are So Unreliable They Warrant Dismissal.

The testimony at the en banc hearing demonstrated that there is a possibility that the initial evidence tube of blood was contaminated by the methamphetamine present in the lab. However, not even the defense expert testified that such an event was likely or even probable. The fact that discrepant results were found in only twelve cases during a period when the Tox Lab tested thousands of blood samples suggests that actual contamination of blood samples or extractions was extremely rare.

Nevertheless, the possibility of contamination of the original evidence tube exists. If there was no way to confirm that the original evidence tube was not compromised, then dismissal might be appropriate. However, in each of the cases before this court, Vial B-as yet unopened-could easily be sent to an outside lab to verify the results obtained from the first vial that was opened in the contaminated Tox Lab. This process was initiated by the Tox Lab in the case of the tenth discrepant result. When the Tox Lab obtained inconsistent levels of methamphetamine in January 2021, it sent the unopened Vial B to an outside lab to confirm the

correct result; the lab waited for that confirmation before issuing its toxicology report. See, Def. Ex. X at  $000801-805.^4$ 

By noting the existence of Vial B, the court is not suggesting the defendants have any burden to test the second vial. Rather, the government could confirm the Tox Lab's results by having Vial B independently tested.

Moreover, in at least two of the cases consolidated before this court, the prejudice from a *possibly* erroneous methamphetamine result is further mitigated by the fact that <u>other drugs</u> were
found in the blood samples. Defendant Markham's blood results show positive for THC as well
as methamphetamine. Thus, should the court suppress the methamphetamine result, there is still
admissible evidence the defendant was under the influence of THC.

Similarly, defendant Neace's blood results showed the presence of morphine and
amphetamine in addition to the methamphetamine results. Therefore, should the court suppress
the methamphetamine/amphetamine result, there is still admissible evidence the defendant was
under the influence of morphine.

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## b. <u>Defendants Have Failed to Demonstrate Prejudice Related to</u> <u>Delay in Resolving Their Cases Due to Government</u> <u>Mismanagement.</u>

The defendants argue the mismanagement by the government forced them to waive their right to a speedy trial numerous times in order to allow their attorneys adequate time to prepare for this hearing and their trial. This argument is without merit. Much of the delay in these three consolidated cases is attributable to the unavoidable circumstances created by the global

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<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>4</sup> Notably, the other discrepant results were ultimately reported out as negative for methamphetamine, thus there is no need to test the second vial of blood.

pandemic, failures to appear by the defendants, or typical requests for continuances by the parties.<sup>5</sup>

For example, Defendant Markham was arraigned in November 2018. He failed to appear for a pretrial hearing on February 14, 2019, and remained on warrant status for approximately nine months. After his warrant was quashed, the case was set for trial in February 11, 2020. That trial date was continued because the defendant was in custody in another jurisdiction. In March 2020, the global pandemic forced the closure of courts across the state including Seattle Municipal Court, creating an extraordinary backlog of cases set for trial. Mr. Markham's case was ultimately rescheduled for trial in October 2020, but because the defendant failed to comply with conditions of release, it was rescheduled for January 13, 2021. A new wave of COVID infections forced the cancellation of jury trials in Seattle Municipal Court from November 2020 to June 2021, and case was reset for trial on August 25, 2021. Defendant sought a continuance to join this motion.

Thus, the delayed disclosure of the methamphetamine contamination until August 2020 had very little, if any, impact on the speed with which Mr. Markham's case was addressed.

Similarly, delays in Mr. Winters' case were due to failures to appear in the fall of 2019, and subsequent defense motions to continue for additional discovery. The pandemic also resulted in delays to pretrial hearings because the court was forced to close from March to July 2020. His case was set for trial in October 2020, but that date was continued on the motion of counsel. The trial was rescheduled to January 13, 2021, but that date was stricken when the court was forced to cancel jury trials due to a COVID surge. An evidentiary motion hearing was held on March 16, 2021, and once jury trials resumed, a new trial date was set for October 13, 2021.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>5</sup> The analysis in this section necessarily relates only to the three cases currently consolidated before the court in this motion. It is theoretically possible that a different outcome might be warranted in a case with different facts.

Defense asked for a continuance and to join the en banc motion. Thus, the trial delays were not attributable to the delayed discovery of methamphetamine contamination but rather to the intervening pandemic.

The case for prejudice due to the delays in Ms. Neace's case are even less compelling. Her arrest occurred in October 2019, but her case was not filed until December 2020, well after the methamphetamine contamination in the lab was disclosed. The only continuances in her case were requested so that her attorney could further investigate the possible impact of the contamination in the Tox Lab on her case, and to decide whether to join the en banc motion.

The defendants have collectively argued undue delay was caused by the Tox Lab's "resistance to providing information" sought by the defense via subpoenas duces tecum. However, the court finds the complexity of the legal issues presented and the volume of documents demanded were the primary reasons the discovery process took so much time. It is evident to the court that once the Tox Lab was aware of its obligation to disclose contamination events to defense attorneys, the Tox Lab made diligent efforts to update disclosure reports and to make information about the discrepant results available to all interested parties.

## B. Any Violation of Brady v. Maryland Occurred Prior to the August 2020 Public Information Disclosure, and Has Already Been Remedied by Suppressing Blood Results Obtained During That Period.

In order to establish a violation under Brady v. Maryland, 373 U.S. 83 (1963), a defendant must establish three things: (1) the evidence at issue must be favorable to the accused, either because it is exculpatory or because it is impeaching; (2) the evidence must have been suppressed by the state either willfully or inadvertently, and (3) prejudice must have ensued. Strickler v. Greene, 527 U.S. 263, 281-82 (1999).

In the instant cases, this court concludes that the government's failure to disclose the contamination from the time it was discovered in May 2019, until the first PID in August 2020, is favorable to the defendants because it is potential impeachment information. Thus, the first Brady prong is satisfied.

Next, the evidence about the contamination was suppressed by the State. The Tox Lab did not disclose the contamination to prosecuting attorneys or defense counsel. As stated above in Section II.A.1.b., this failure to disclose the impeachment information was a breach of the duty of the Tox Lab. Tox Lab personnel testified that they were unaware of the need to disclose this information, thus the suppression of the information was inadvertent. Nevertheless, the breach of the duty to disclose satisfies the second <u>Brady</u> prong.

However, considering the third prong, the defendants cannot demonstrate prejudice. Washington courts typically describe the <u>Brady</u> prejudice requirement in terms of "materiality." Evidence is material under <u>Brady</u> if there is a reasonable probability that, had the evidence been disclosed to the defense, the result of the proceeding would have been different. <u>State v. Davila</u>, 184 Wn.2d 55, 73 (2015). The materiality requirement is more directly applicable to the situation where evidence favorable to the defense is discovered after the trial has concluded. For example, in <u>Davila</u>, the court ruled that the evidence of a toxicologist's ineptitude was favorable as impeachment evidence, but would not have been likely to change the result of the trial because a second toxicologist had separately conducted DNA analysis on different pieces of evidence that implicated the defendant. <u>Davila</u>, 184 Wn.2d at 78.

Even when <u>Brady</u> evidence is discovered after a trial, dismissal is rarely the appropriate remedy. <u>United States v. Pasha</u>, 797 F.3d 1122, 1139 (D.C. Cir. 2015). The remedy for a <u>Brady</u> violation that comes to light before trial is a continuance so the parties may properly assess the

evidence for use at trial. See State v. Ramos, 83 Wash App. 622, 636 (1996) (discussing CrR 4.7 violations). Moreover, if the evidence could have been discovered by the exercise of due diligence by the defense, there is no Brady violation. State v. Mullen, 171 Wn.2d 881, 896 (2011).

In our case, defense has all of the impeachable evidence prior to trial, and the cases have been continued to allow for this litigation. The Tox Lab's initial failure to disclose the contamination in the lab prior to the first PID is potentially a Brady violation because the Tox Lab is a governmental agency tasked with analyzing evidence for criminal prosecutions. However, any violation of Brady was remedied by the PID issued on August 7, 2020, and by subsequent efforts of the Tox Lab and City Attorney's Office to disclose relevant material sought by the defense. Therefore, while the Brady violation contributes to the "mismanagement" that is the basis for our suppression ruling, it does not by itself warrant suppression of the late-disclosed evidence.

C.

## ER 702 Does Not Warrant Suppression of Blood Results.

ER 702 reads, "If scientific, technical, or other specialized knowledge will assist the trier of fact to understand the evidence or to determine a fact in issue, a witness qualified as an expert by knowledge, skill, experience, training, or education, may testify thereto in the form of an opinion or otherwise." The two-part test to be applied under this rule is whether (1) the witness qualifies as an expert and (2) the expert testimony would be helpful to the trier of fact. State v. Kalakosky, 121 Wn.2d 525, 541 (1993). Tests to detect the presence of alcohol or drugs in DUI cases are governed by highly detailed statutes and administrative regulations. Assuming police, investigators and lab technicians have fully complied with the procedures specified by the statutes and administrative regulations, the admissibility of the test is usually not at issue.

However, if the testimony before the trial court shows that a given testing procedure was so flawed as to be unreliable, then the court may use its discretion to exclude test results because they are not "helpful to the trier of fact." <u>State v. Kalakosky</u>, 121 Wn.2d 525 at 541.

In <u>Kalakosky</u>, defendant argued on appeal that the trial court erred in admitting DNA
evidence under ER 702 because the reliability of the DNA analysis was undermined by two
human errors that occurred in the laboratory. <u>Kalakosky</u>, 121 Wn.2d 525 at 541-42. In rejecting
the defense argument, the Court concluded,

Whether the spill or the initially mislabeled autoradiograph affected the reliability of the test is a question of fact. Alleged infirmities in the performance of a test usually go to the weight of the evidence, not to its admissibility. One commentator has pointed out that courts should not automatically exclude scientific evidence whenever the forensic analyst deviates from correct test protocol in any minor respect; rather the deviation would have to materially affect the test outcome to warrant exclusion. While there might be situations where irregularities in a laboratory testing procedure could be the basis for excluding the test results from evidence, the irregularities which occurred here do not warrant such exclusion.

15 Id. at 543. (citations omitted)

16 In the instant cases, while the court finds there was government mismanagement in the 17 operation of the Tox Lab between March 2018 when testing began in the Annex, and October 18 2021 when NIST found no more contamination, the court does not find the mismanagement 19 materially affected the defendants' blood test results to a degree "so flawed as to be unreliable." 20 Id. During the en banc hearing, there was no evidence presented to establish the results in 21 defendants' specific cases were inaccurate or unreliable. Therefore, under ER 702, the court 22 finds the mismanagement at the lab does not warrant exclusion, and any irregularities in the 23 24 testing procedure goes to weight of the evidence, not the admissibility. 25

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# D. <u>Defendants Have Failed to Establish The City Is Committing A Due Process</u> Violation By Seeking to Admit "False" or "Unreliable" Evidence.

Defendants argue the City knows or should know the blood results are "unreliable" and, therefore, the City is violating the defendants' due process rights by seeking to admit false evidence. <u>Def. Brief</u>, pg. 87. To support their position, defendants cite <u>State v. Roche</u>, 114 Wash. App. 424 (2002). <u>Roche</u> involved convictions for methamphetamine possession. <u>Roche</u>, 114 Wash. App. at 428-29. After Roche and another defendant were convicted and sentenced following separate jury trials, it became public knowledge the crime lab chemist who tested the methamphetamine and provided testimony was "self-medicating" with heroin sent to the crime lab. <u>Id.</u> The chemist was subsequently charged and pled guilty to evidence tampering and official misconduct, and Roche and the other defendant were granted new trials based on newly discovered evidence.

<u>Roche</u> is not on point. In the instant cases, no evidence was presented showing members of the Tox Lab falsified evidence, nor is there any evidence the defendants' specific test results are false, unreliable or involve discrepant results due to lab contamination. Consequently, consistent with our ruling regarding ER 702, defendants have failed to establish the City is seeking to admit "false" or "unreliable" evidence.

## III. ORDER

1. Defendants' motion to dismiss the cases pursuant to CrRLJ 8.3(b) is denied.

2. Defendants' motion to suppress for failure to comply with ER 702 is denied.

3. Defendants' motion to suppress Amphetamine and Methamphetamine blood results is granted. Pursuant to CrRLJ 8.3(b), the court finds Tox Lab mismanagement for failing to adequately clean the Annex when it moved in, and for continuing to test for Amphetamine and Methamphetamine in the Main Lab while there was documented contamination. The court also

1	finds suppression is appropriate because the Tox Lab violated Brady by failing to notify
2	prosecutors and defense attorneys of the contamination until August 2020.
3	4. The court suppresses all blood toxicology results related to Amphetamine and
4	Methamphetamine tested in the Main Lab and the Annex between March 2018 and October
6	2021. This ruling does not affect tests for alcohol or any other drug.
7	5. In the matter of City of Seattle v. Christopher Markham, case no. 637660, the blood
8	test results of Amphetamine 0.13 mg/l and Methamphetamine 0.96 mg/l are suppressed. The test
